Description of Cares

In the past few months, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act has provided much-needed funding for education. These funds were provided to help entities within Utah to respond to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Utah State Legislature and Governor's Office have assigned the Utah Education and Telehealth Network (UETN) the responsibility to administer a portion of the State, Local Government and Tribal Government category of CARES. These funds are being distributed to Utah's higher education institutions, technical colleges, public libraries, public education institutions and multiple health care providers.
