\$9 MILLION

APPROPRIATED BY UT LEGISLATURE IN HB 5010
Managed by **Utah Division of Arts & Museums**

- Open to organizations with annual budgets of \$5M or greater
- **16** applications received from for-profit and nonprofit organizations
- **\$14.6** million in total funding requested

Grants will be finalized by August 20 and distributed immediately thereafter



COVID-19 RACIAL EQUITY AND INCLUSION GRANTS

\$1 MILLION

APPROPRIATED BY UT LEGISLATURE IN HB 5010
Managed by **Utah Division of Multicultural Affairs**

- Grants open to nonprofit organizations serving basic needs of multicultural communities
- **103** applications in process to-date
- **\$4.3** million in total funding requested to-date

Grants will close on August 21 and award decisions will be made/funded in early September
