


HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOM FUNDING

One-time EPA grant to DEQ used to replace \$200,000 ongoing HABs monitoring costs and laboratory fees.

Project Funding: One-time from Sovereign Lands Restricted Account

Amount: \$500,000

Intent: To fund projects to address harmful algal blooms on Utah Lake.

Harmful Algal Bloom Funding: Ongoing from General Funds since 2019.

Amount: \$200,000/year

Intent: To fund The Division of Water Quality and local health departments efforts **to monitor for harmful algal blooms throughout the state** and provide public health advisories.


Current Funding: One-time Grant from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency

Amount: \$104,000

Intent: One-time partial replacement of the \$300,000 lost funding. This grant will fund monitoring at 18 priority waterbodies designated by local health departments.

HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOM PROGRAM SUMMARY


UTAH HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOM PROGRAM 2017-19
