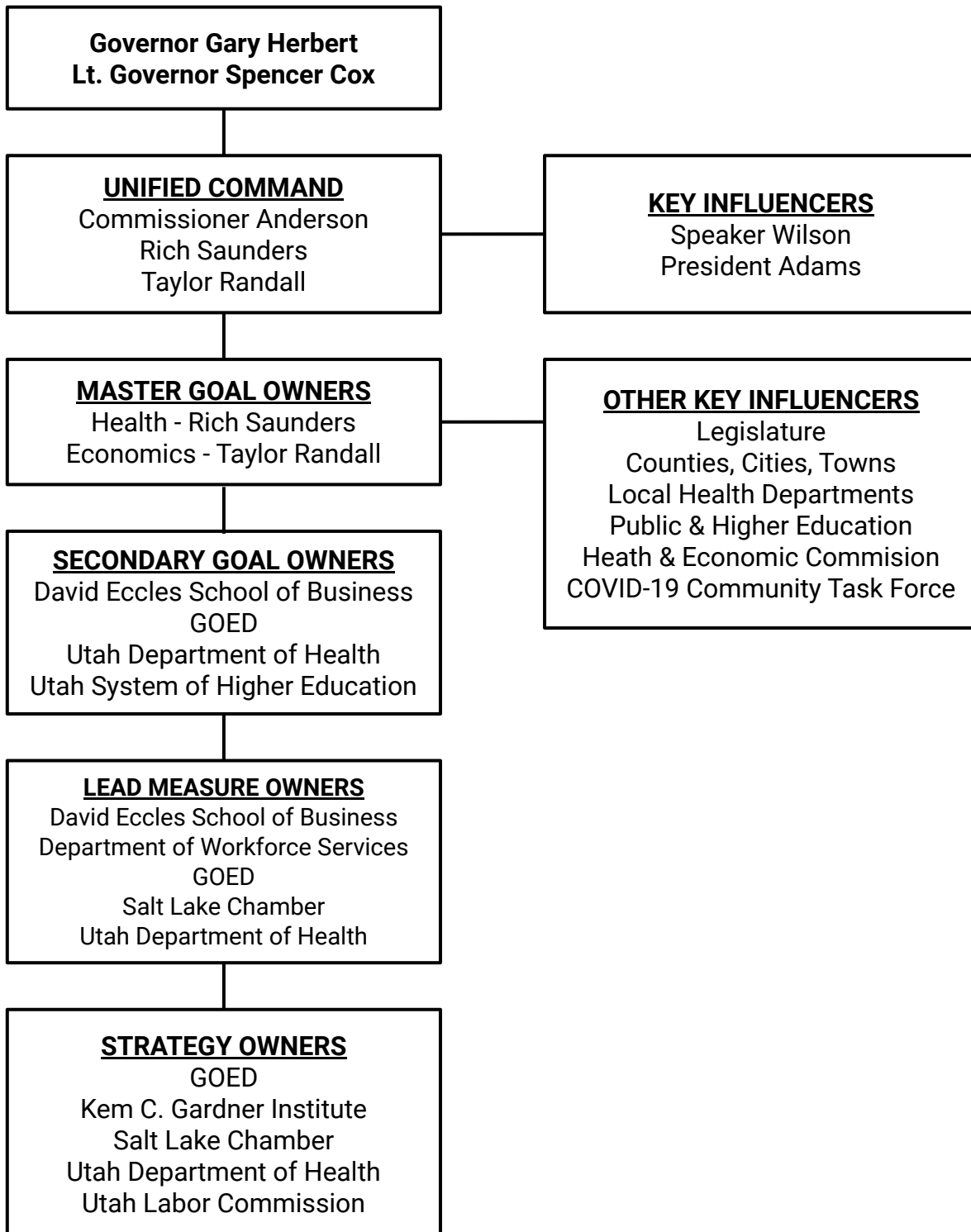


STATE OF UTAH UNIFIED RESPONSE PLAN

Several state entities have come together, including both the Executive and Legislative Branches, to create a Unified Response Plan that comprehensively addresses COVID-19 in the state of Utah. This plan seeks to best leverage resources and for everyone involved to move in the same direction.



STATE OF UTAH UNIFIED RESPONSE PLAN

Unified Mission: *Minimize sickness and death by COVID-19, while protecting long-term social and economic health in all Utah communities.*

The plan is composed of two Master Goals, six Secondary Goals, and 13 Lead Measures. Lead Measures are designed to accomplish their related Secondary Goals; Secondary Goals are designed to accomplish their related Master Goal.

MASTER GOAL #1 - CASE FATALITY RATIO < 1%

Secondary Goals:

- 7 day rolling average cases per day < 400 by 9/1/2020
(note: this will decrease to 300, then 200 in a stepwise approach)
- ICU Utilization Overall <85% of ICU beds
- Rapid Response & Containment of Outbreaks – 90% successful by 9/1/20

MASTER GOAL #2 - UNEMPLOYMENT 4.5% BY 12/31/2020

Secondary Goals:

- Increase consumer confidence from current state to 118.8 by 12/31/2020
- Increase job placements with unemployed and furloughed individuals resulting in decrease in unemployment weekly claims by 12/31/2020
- Increase enrollment and attainment in all Learn and Work, short-term and certificate training programs
