

**Boards and Commissions Database and Reporting
Status Update, September 2020**

H.B. 10 Boards and Commissions Amendments

Requires the Utah Public Notice Website and the Governor's boards and commissions database to share information "as soon as reasonably possible within existing funds appropriated to the division and the Governor's Office."

Changes annual report of all executive boards and commissions to a five-year reporting cycle before August 2024.

Continue to review and evaluate of all boards created the prior calendar year.

S.B. 146 Boards and Commissions Modifications

The funding, which would have been used to implement system changes related to SB 60 and SB 146, was all pulled back during the 2020 5th Special Session.
