Industrial Hemp Program:

UDAF's Industrial Hemp Program provides regulatory oversight for identification, cultivation, processing, testing and distribution of hemp-based products.

Industrial Hemp Program Team

- Permitting of retail establishments selling hemp products.
- Consumer safety and product honesty.





Industrial Hemp Inspector Responsibilities

Verify Compliance:

- Inspection and Sampling of Hemp Growers
- Inspection and Sampling of Hemp Processors
- Inspection and Testing Product Registration

Licensed Entities & Fees

- As of September 11, 2020
 - 212 licensed hemp growers (since January) \$500 per license
 - 85 licensed hemp processors (since January 1) \$2000 per license
 - 1554 registered hemp products (since July 1) \$250 for cannabinoid products; \$125 for seed products plus \$75 service fee.
 - 473 Retail Establishment permits (since July 1) \$50 per location.



Checks & Balances

Inspection & Compliance

- Along with the hemp licenses and trying to grow the number of registered products, our inspectors also help in medical marijuana. So we have set a goal to have our inspection team meet 550 inspections per year.
 - 90 medical cannabis production sites
 - 110 hemp growers
 - 70 hemp processors
 - 270 product inspections
- 550 inspections with 2 months taken to take hemp harvest samples full time. Approximately 700 per year.
