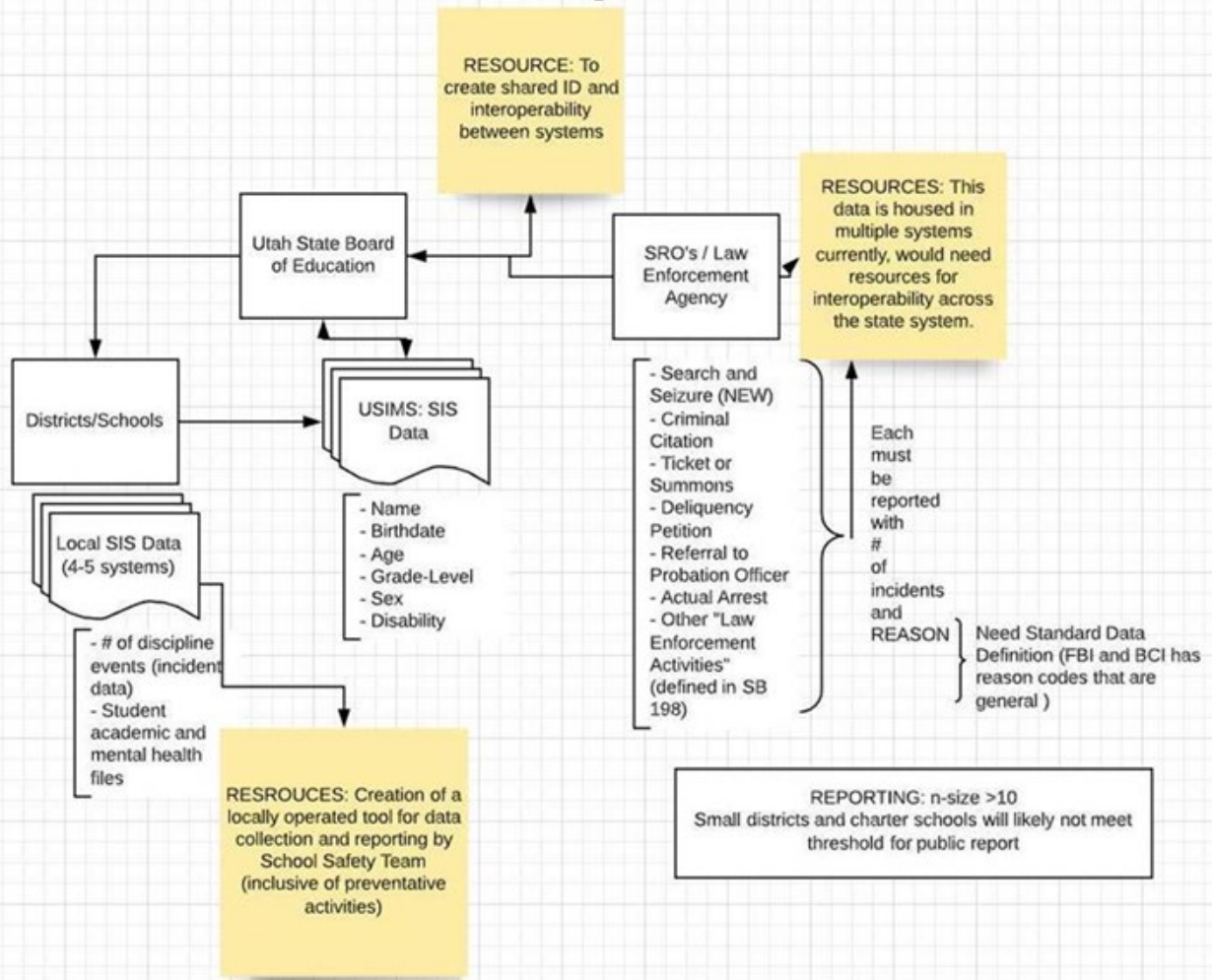

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SRO's / Law Enforcement Agency

**RESOURCES: This data is housed in multiple systems currently, would need resources for interoperability across the state system.**

Districts/Schools

USIMS: SIS Data

Local SIS Data (4-5 systems)

- Name
- Birthdate
- Age
- Grade-Level
- Sex
- Disability

- # of discipline events (incident data)
- Student academic and mental health files

**RESOURCES: Creation of a locally operated tool for data collection and reporting by School Safety Team (inclusive of preventative activities)**

- Search and Seizure (NEW)
- Criminal Citation
- Ticket or Summons
- Delinquency Petition
- Referral to Probation Officer
- Actual Arrest
- Other "Law Enforcement Activities" (defined in SB 198)

Each must be reported with # of incidents and REASON

Need Standard Data Definition (FBI and BCI has reason codes that are general)

**REPORTING: n-size >10**  
Small districts and charter schools will likely not meet threshold for public report

## Next Steps

- Data requirements are an integral part of the student component of USBE's Utah School Information Management System (USIMS)
  - USBE just began the student portion of USIMS and does not anticipate the student portion of USIMS being interoperable any earlier than the 2021-22 school year
- Address Concerns raised by UJDRC report
