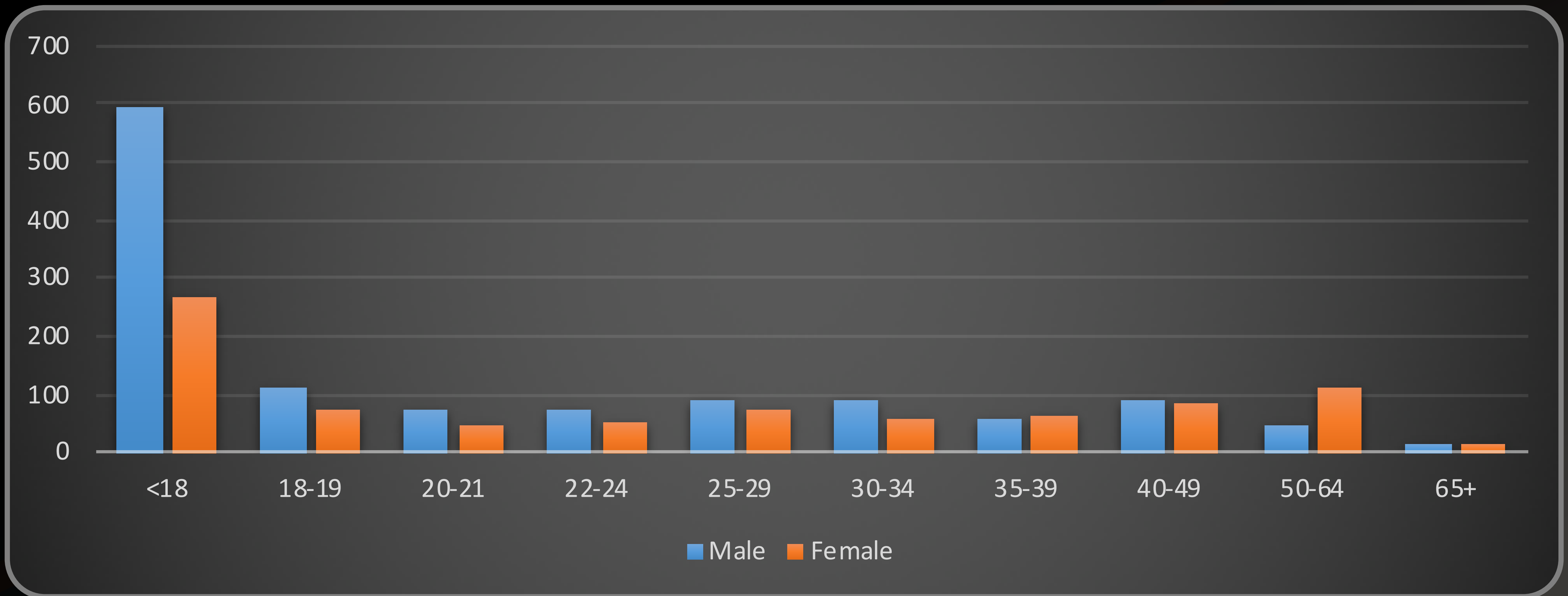
HEADCOUNT BY LENGTH

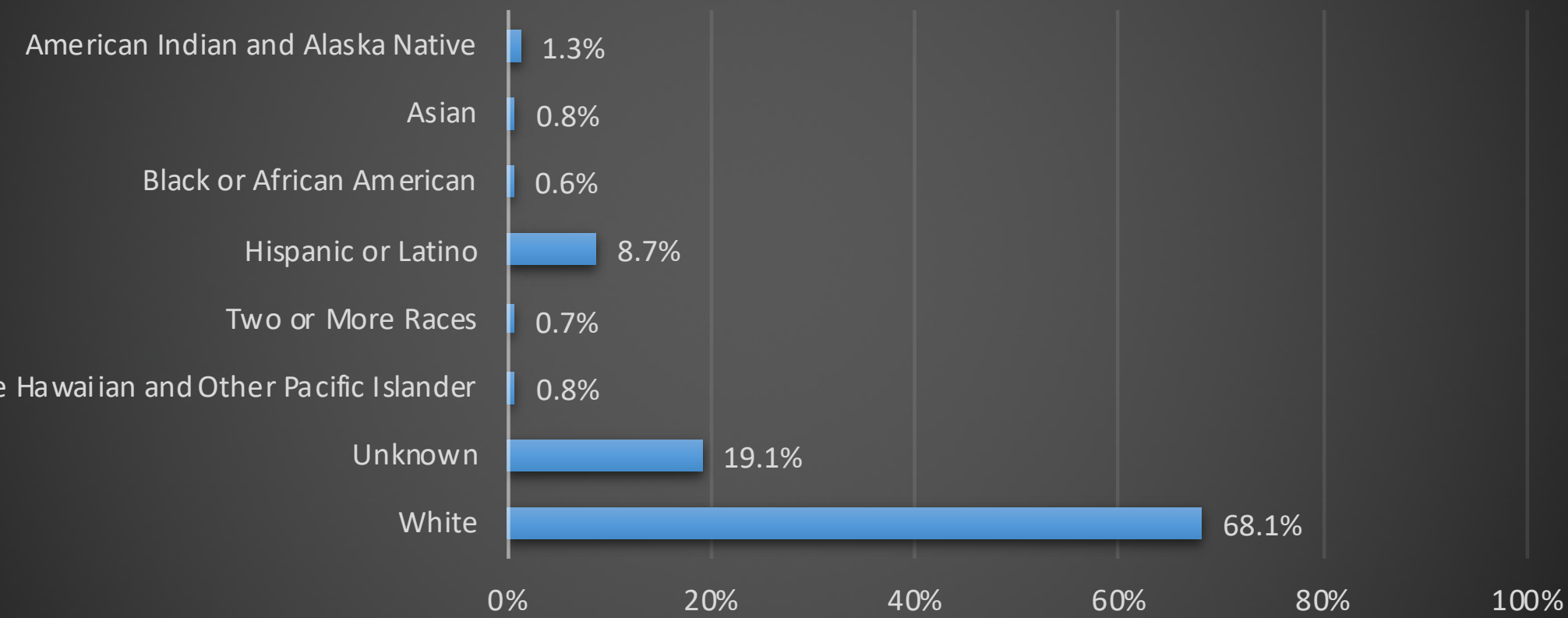


HEADCOUNT BY AGE & GENDER

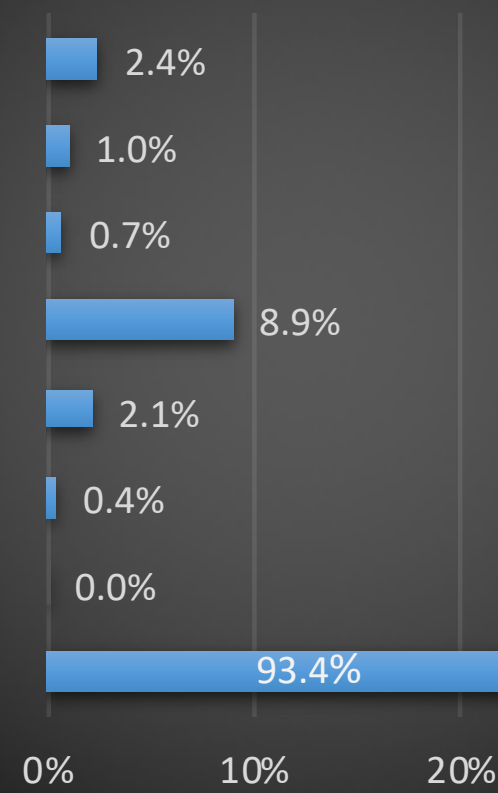

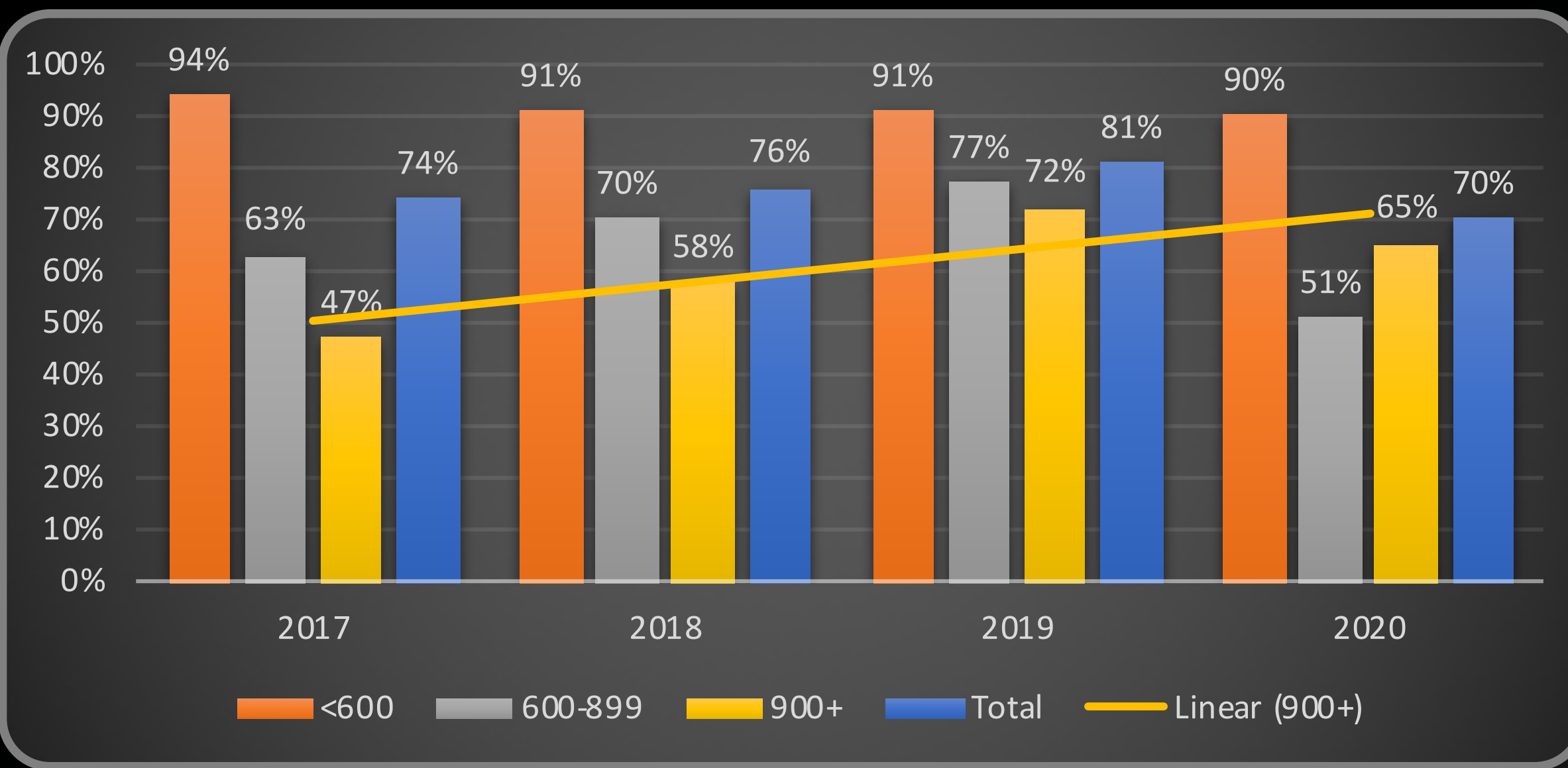


CERTIFICATES AWARDED BY LENGTH

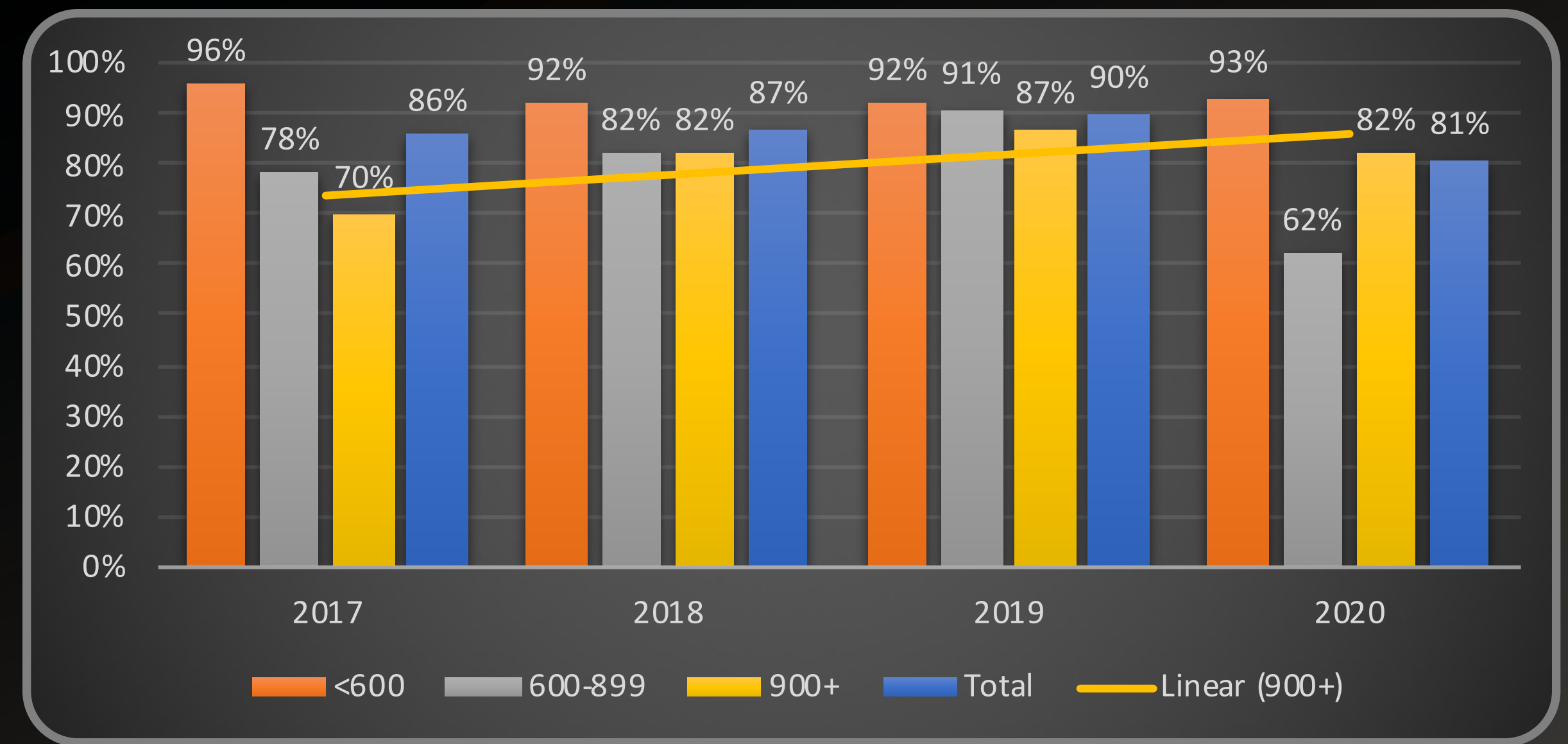

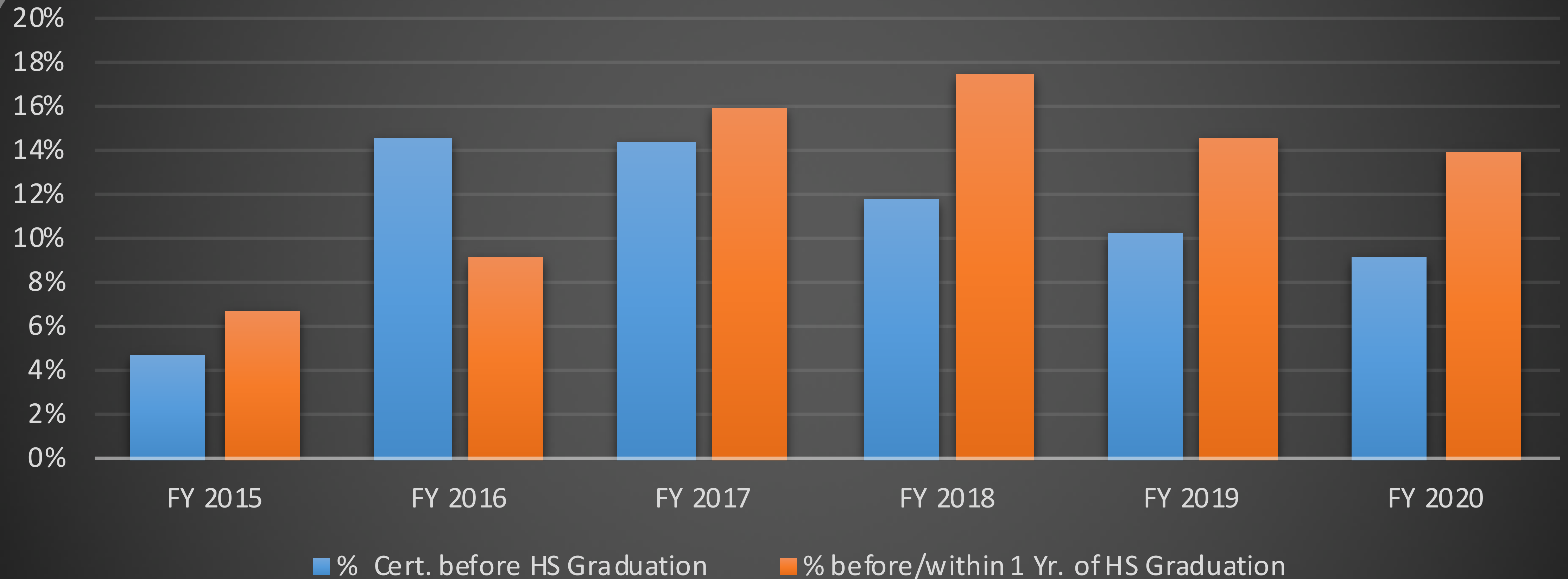

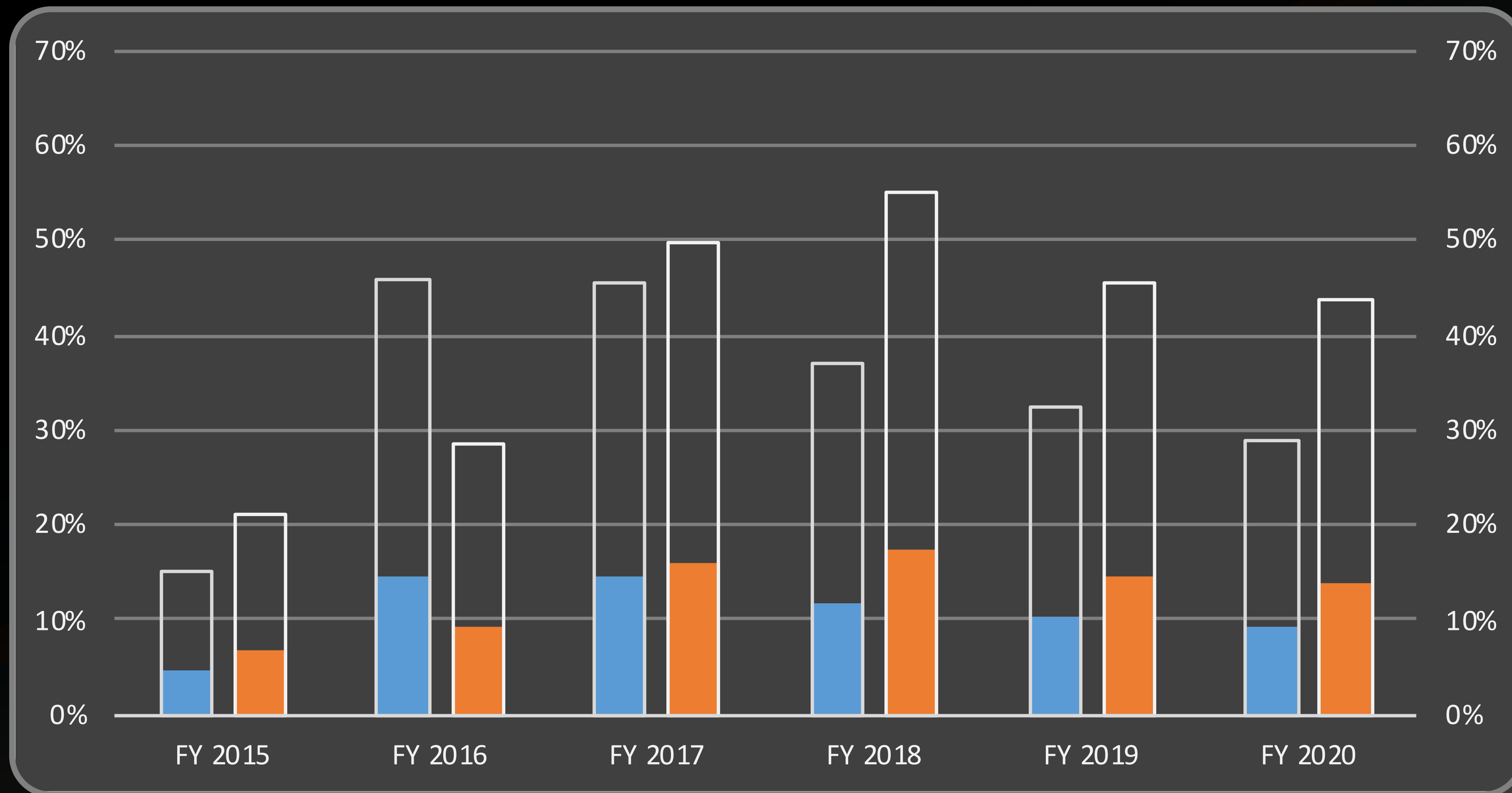

Automotive Technician Expansion

\$95,000

Need: Program expansion to meet demand

Deliverable: Expansion of secondary offerings & 5 adult spots, plus 8,000 hours of training.



P R I O R I T Y 3

Pharmacy Technician

\$97,373

Need: Program expansion to meet demand

Deliverable: Additional instruction, 15 completers per year
