Three Components of State Family Dental Clinics:

- Salt Lake City Clinic
- Academy Square (Ogden)Clinic
- Mobile Outreach Program

Populations served:

- Underserved adult and pediatric patients, e.g.:
 - -Eligible Medicaid populations
 - -others: e.g., Veterans and refugee programs
 - -Statewide Mobile grant and regional/local programs

-Historical perspective

Pandemic effect:

- due to fiscal issues, Family Dental clinics/operations required to close August-October 2020
- University of Utah School of Dentistry volunteered to assume responsibility for these clinics and patients UUSOD network---no state cost, but preserve services to needy populations

-Conditions:

Lease: Renewable 2 year lease; space as is, without modifications


- Assumed responsibility for all
 - -equipment and furnishings
- -patients on record (~????)
- Assumed ownership end of October and will open mid-Feb. (Rose Park) and mid March (Ogden) of 2021

Description of Family Dental (*ROSE PARK*) Salt Lake Office-Location: 168 N, 1950 W.

- State adult/pediatric Primary Dental Care
- Mobile van on road 1 week/month to provide local underserved care
- Medicaid, special needy populations, and some cash-paying patients
- ~7,752 ft2
 - -12 operatories
- ~2 full time dentists currently;
 - -Others: ~4 dental students, 2-4 hygiene students, GPR residents, and 4 staff
- Mobile van, 30 mobile units, 1 dentist and program manager


