

# HB132 Sanitation Amendments

## COSMETOLOGY

&

## BODY ART FACILITIES



Cosmetology facilities: barbering, cosmetology/barbering, electrology, esthetics, master-level esthetics, hair design, nail technology.

\*Body art facilities: body piercing, tattooing, permanent cosmetics, microblading.

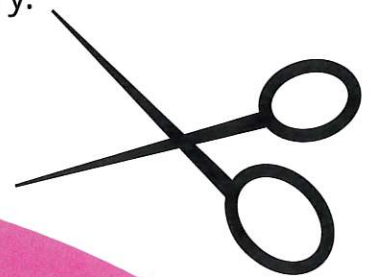
\*Currently body art facilities are not defined in Utah Code.

## ACCOUNTABILITY

HB132 would require cosmetology and body art facilities to post a notice that includes:

- Local health department contact information
- The website containing the rules regulating a facility
- The 5 most common sanitary issues that must be addressed
- Information encouraging sanitary conditions

Facilities would obtain the informational notice from their local health department and post the notice in a place visible upon entry.



## COVID-19 COMPLIANT

Informational notices will be created by local health departments. Cosmetology and body art facilities that fail to post the notice may be fined **\$500**. These requirements will only apply in counties that don't hold yearly inspections.
