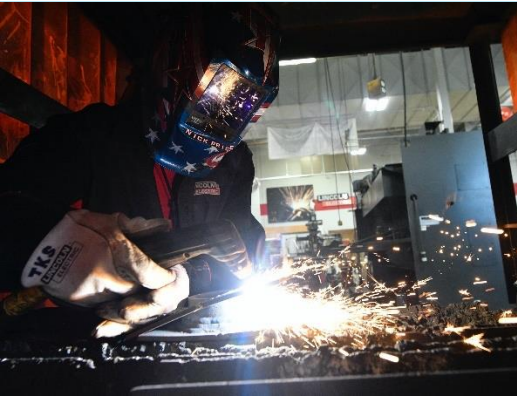

- comply with standards of behavior,
- meet tenth grade or higher reading and math competencies,
- have obtained a high school diploma/GED, and
- are within five years of release.

RECIDIVISM

Participating students who graduate from Davis Tech programs have a recidivism rate at least **20% lower** than the comparable population.

PATHWAYS TO COMPLETION AND BEYOND

If released before completion, students can **transition seamlessly** to complete their programs at Davis Tech. All program pathways and articulation opportunities apply, and students can pursue federal financial aid and scholarships.

PLACEMENT ASSISTANCE

The Davis Tech **Job Placement Specialist visits quarterly** and assists with résumé writing and interviewing skills. Ongoing placement assistance is also available.
