90%

90% of all registered voters cast votes in the 2020 presidential election- the highest percentage of participation ever.

Over 1.6 million Utah citizens registered to vote in the 2020 election (about 69% of Utah's eligible population).

Vote by mail has been practiced in Utah since 2012 for local elections and has increased voter turnout.

Over 92% of Utah voters cast their votes by mail in 2020. This is 4% higher than 2018, and 27% higher than 2016.

Only 0.8% of ballots were rejected (a similar rate to past years) for being late or signatures not matching.

This was the highest Utah voter participation turnout since 1964 (Johnson vs. Goldwater).

Utah had the second highest increase in voter turnout nationally from 2016-2020.

There were no significant reports of voter or election fraud in the Utah election.
