- 33 {(b)} (2) The department may recommend consideration of screening and testing during the

"Childhood Lead Testing Prevention and Education Restricted Account." 56

57 (b) The restricted account consists of:

(i) money appropriated to the restricted account by the Legislature; 58

(ii) private donations; and -59

60 (iii) all income and interest derived from the deposit and investment of money in the

61 account.

(c) Subject to legislative appropriations, money in the restricted account may be used 62

63 to fund activities related to the program created in this section.
