Why HB195?

1. Great Customer Experience

- a. Modernize Registration
- b. Auto-renewal
- c. Implement familiar commercial practices

2. Reduce Regulatory Burden

- a. Simplifies renewal for commercial fleets
- b. Reduce the hassle and burden to taxpayers by using auto-renewal

Fleet Vehicle Decals

Currently managing sticker replacement and management for a Utah based company can be very burdensome, costly, and inefficient

- Many vehicles
- Vehicle may be across the state
- Individual renewal for every vehicle

HB 195 - Allows special, permanent registration decals for Vehicles that are part of a commercial fleet, and renewal is at the same month.

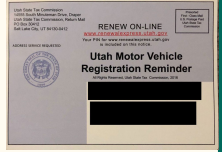
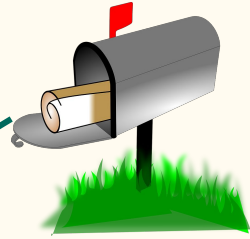

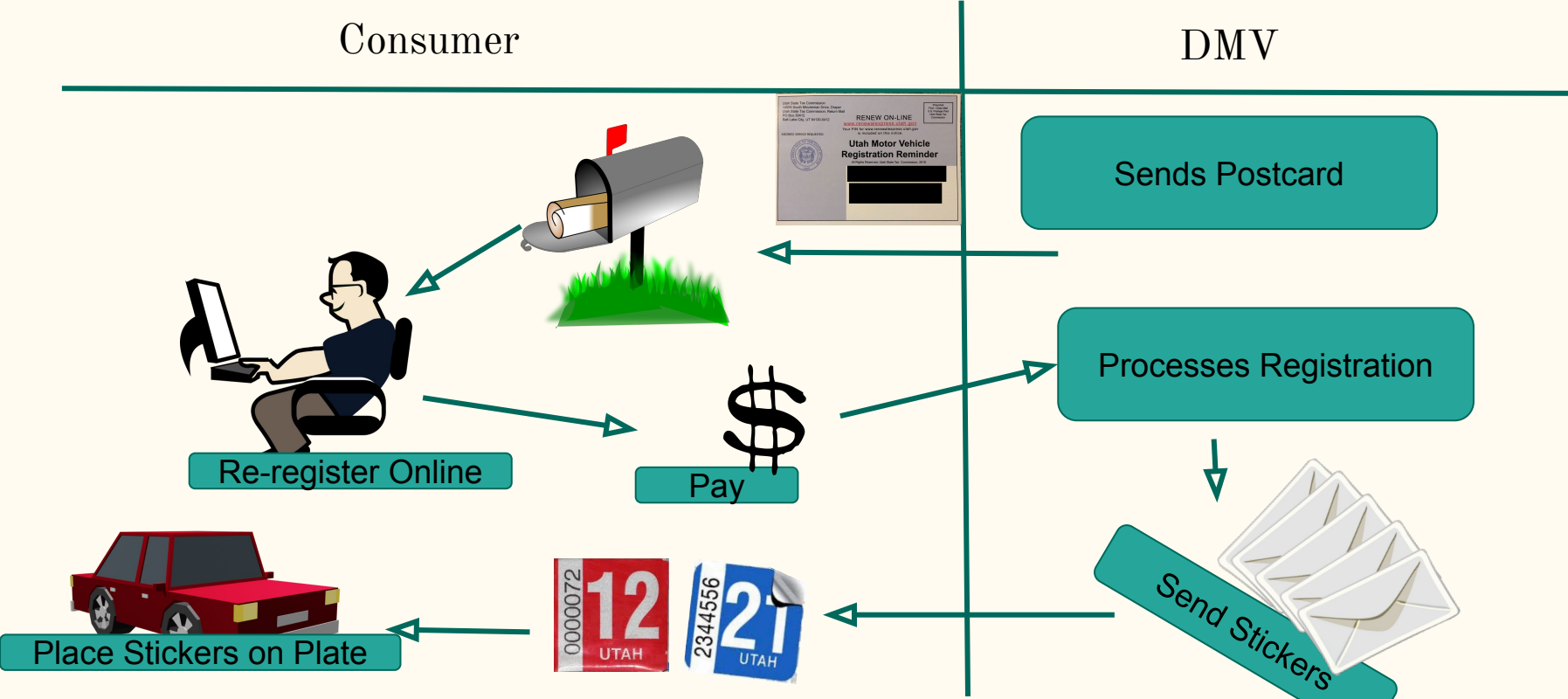

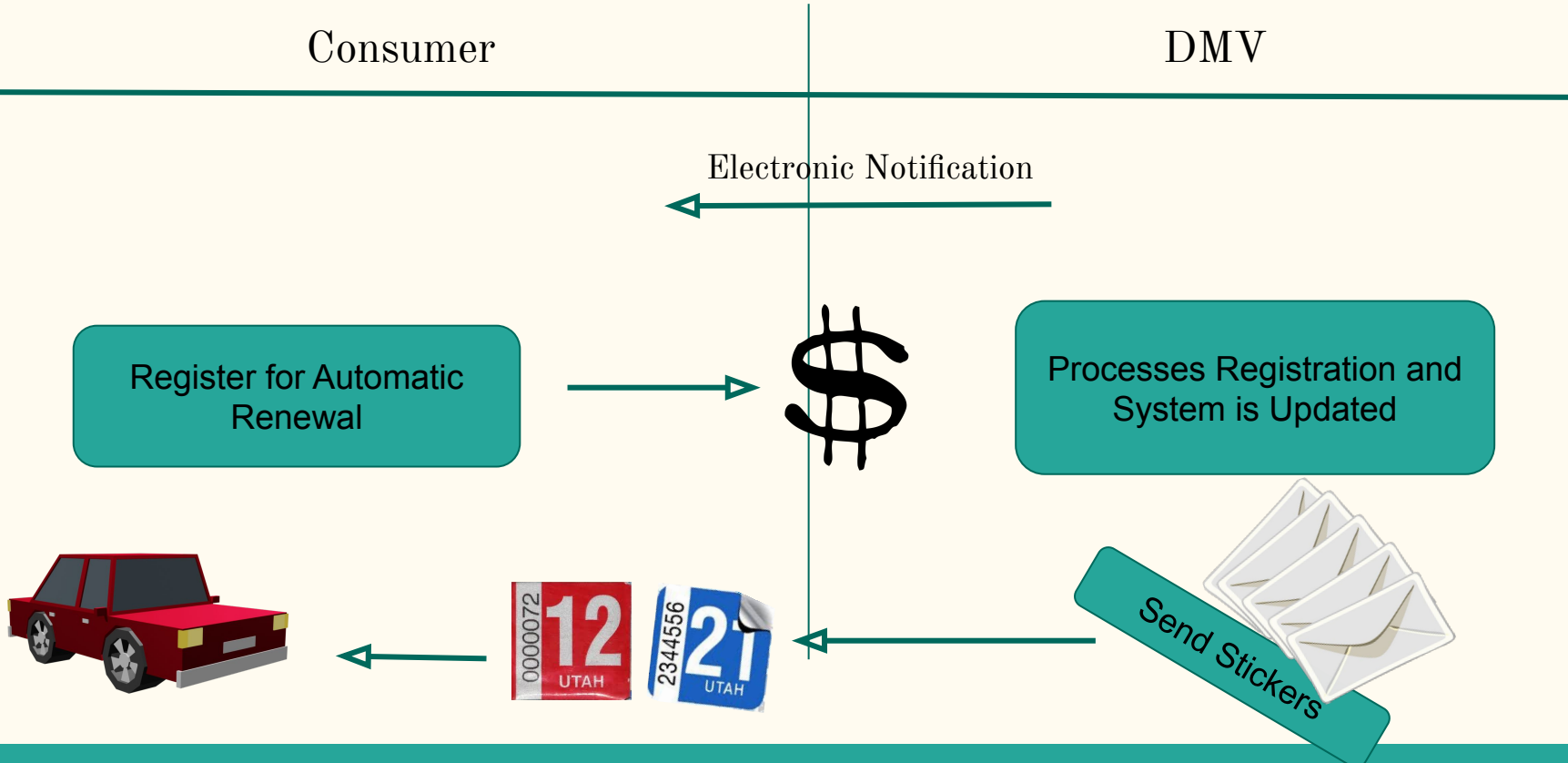

Comparing 2nd and 3rd Substitute

3rd Substitute Option

- Taxpayers save \$1 if they choose auto-renewal
- Tax Commision saves the cost of printing, sending, and administering postcards
- Promotes auto-renewal, which will result in fewer expired plates & citations
