

Cyclist Traffic Amendments

HB 142 Rep. Carol Moss

This bill allows a cyclist to proceed through an intersection without stopping at the stop sign, if they slow down, yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian, other traffic within the intersection, and oncoming traffic.

FACTS

- States with similar policies have seen a reduction in injury rates to cyclists
- A **14% drop** was reported by Idaho in the first year and those rates have maintained after 29 years
- A **23% drop** was reported by Delaware after the first three years of implementation
