

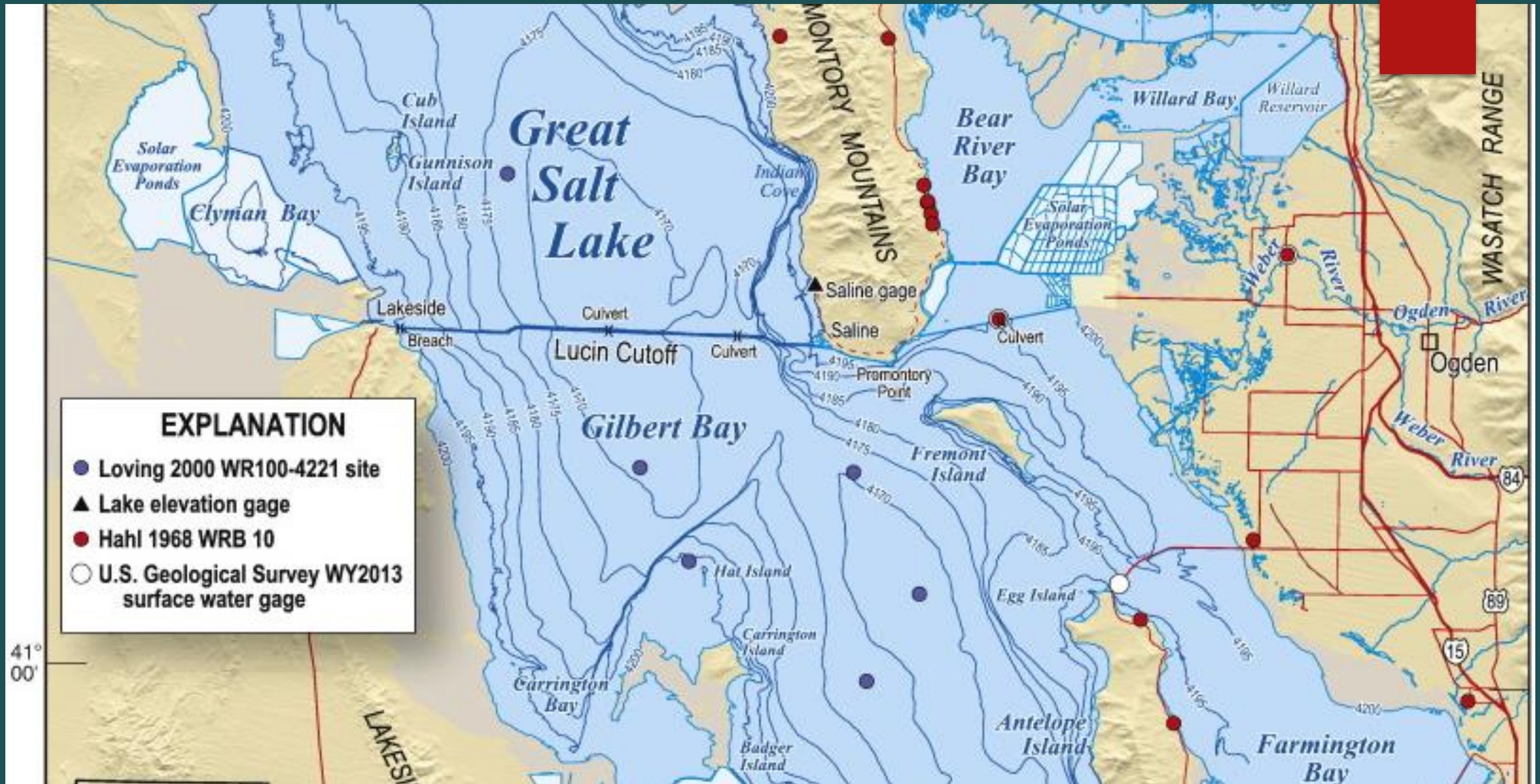

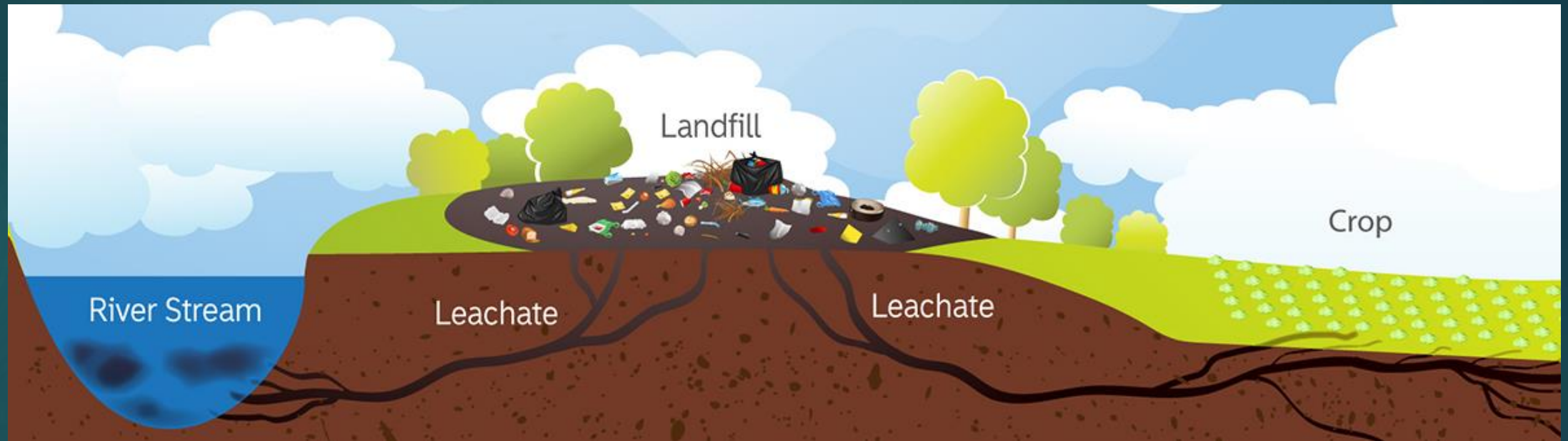












Class V Waste Approvals

- ▶ Application
- ▶ Legislative Approval
- ▶ Needs Assessment
- ▶ Governor's Approval

Process Concerns – A Blank Check?

- ▶ Approval granted in 2016 (Lee Perry)
 - ▶ Economic development opportunity
 - ▶ Many legislators felt duped
- ▶ Concerns raised
- ▶ Concerns dismissed ("Hell Hole")
- ▶ Application withdrawn
- ▶ Late 2020, application refiled

Original Bill (HB-399) – No More Blank Checks

- ▶ Legislative approval must FOLLOW the filing of an application.
- ▶ If an applicant withdraws an application, must start the process over.
- ▶ *Retroactive Effect.*

1st Sub – HB-399

- ▶ *Eliminates Retroactive Effect.*
- ▶ *For **Future** Applications ...*
 - ▶ Legislative approval must follow filing of the application.
 - ▶ If application is withdrawn, must start over.
 - ▶ 5 year expiration date if application not approved by the Division.
