HB94 Microenterprise Home Kitchen Amendments

What is a Microenterprise Home Kitchen?

A Microenterprise Home Kitchen is a non-commercial kitchen facility located in a private home where food is handled, stored, prepared, or offered for sale.

Throughout the Covid-19 Pandemic many Utah households have found themselves struggling financially. Many people turned to selling desserts, meal prep, and other food items from their homes on platforms such as Facebook Marketplace in order to make ends meet without usual sources of income.

How can those who purchase these items know that they were made in a sanitary environment?

HB94 gives these Microenterprise Home Kitchens a chance to receive a permit issued by a local health department. This permit will bring validity to their home business and ensure customer safety while allowing these Microenterprise Home Kitchens to bring in much needed side income. This bill will protect them as well as customers.
