

- Dedicated staff positions evaluating bond amounts
- Active idle well management
- Administrative Penalties
- Data driven decision making

Purpose of Bonds

- Well plugging and site reclamation
- Address waste or pollution issues
- Protects surface land owners
- Reduces risk to state and taxpayers





Orphan wells in Utah

- 41 Orphan wells
- Active Program since 1992
 - Plugged 117 wells
- Source of Funding
 - · Bond forfeitures
 - · Conservation fund dollars
 - · Potential Infrastructure Bill funding
- Cost Range
 - Site Specific
 - \$7,000-\$150,000

What has been done

- 2020 Penalty Statute in SB 148
- 2020 full time position dedicated to idle well management
- 2021 Funding Severance Tax SB 133

In Progress

- 2021 Idle Well Workflow Application and Prioritization Module
- 2021 Bond Review Module

- Attorney General position
- Appropriation increase
- Completion of Bonding Rulemaking
