(1) The statewide resource management plan, dated [January 2, 2018] November 10,
<u>2021</u> , and	d on file with the office, is hereby adopted.
(2	2) The office shall, to the extent possible and as funding allows, monitor federal, state,
and local	government compliance with the plan.
(3	3) (a) If the office [modifies] finds the need to modify the plan, the office shall notify
the comn	nission of the modification and the office's reasoning for the modification [within 30]
