S.B. 78

- 1. Page 4, Lines 97 through 104:
- 97 (d) Beginning on January 1, 2023:
- 98 (i) the board of education of a school district with a student population of 50,000 or
- 99 more students but fewer than 100,000 students:
- 100 (A) except as provided in Subsection (1)(d)(i)(B), comprises seven members; or

- 101 (B) comprises nine members if the { applicable legislative body } board of education of the school district ,
by majority vote.
- 102 increases the board to nine members; and
- 103 (ii) the board of education of a school district with a student population of 100,000 or
- 104 more students comprises nine members.
