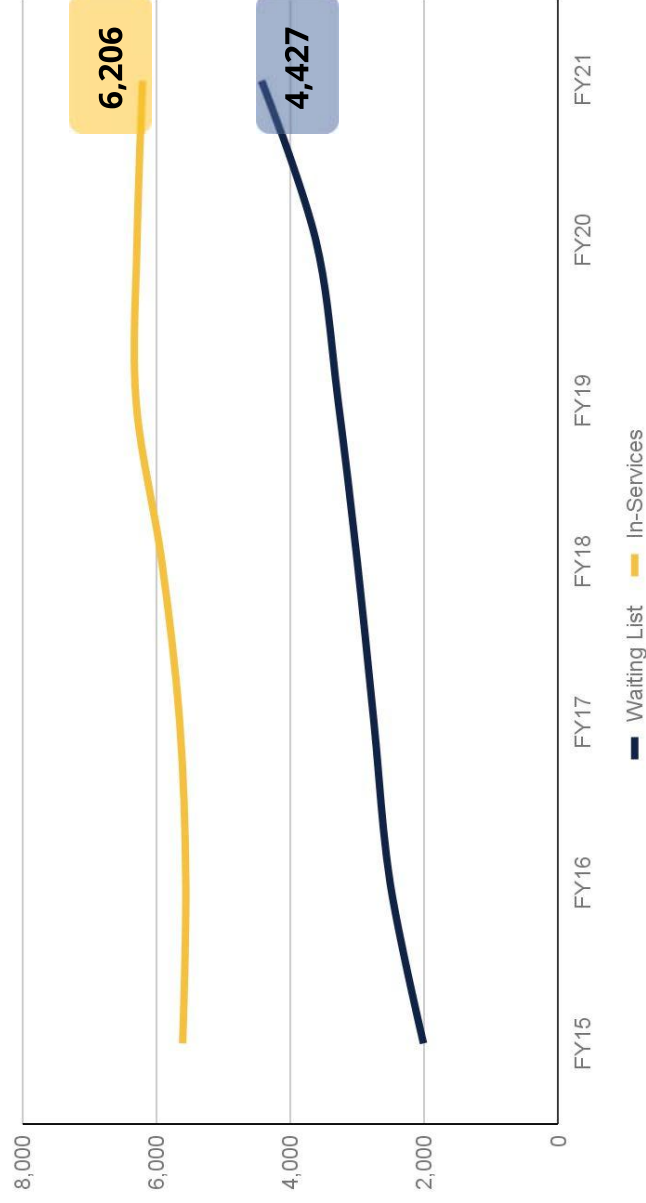

Need For DSPD Services

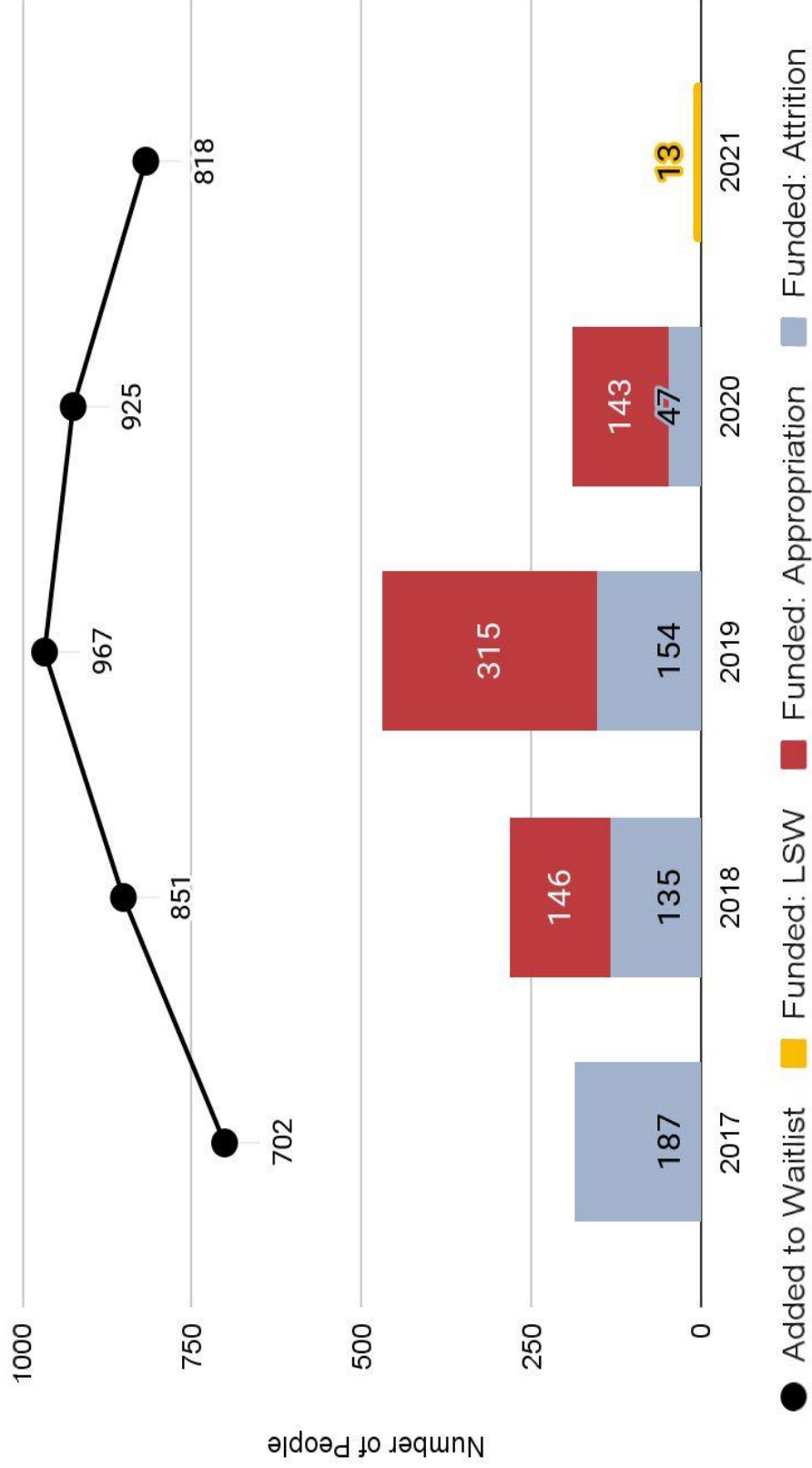
Annual Count of Individuals Waiting and In-Service

Service Demand

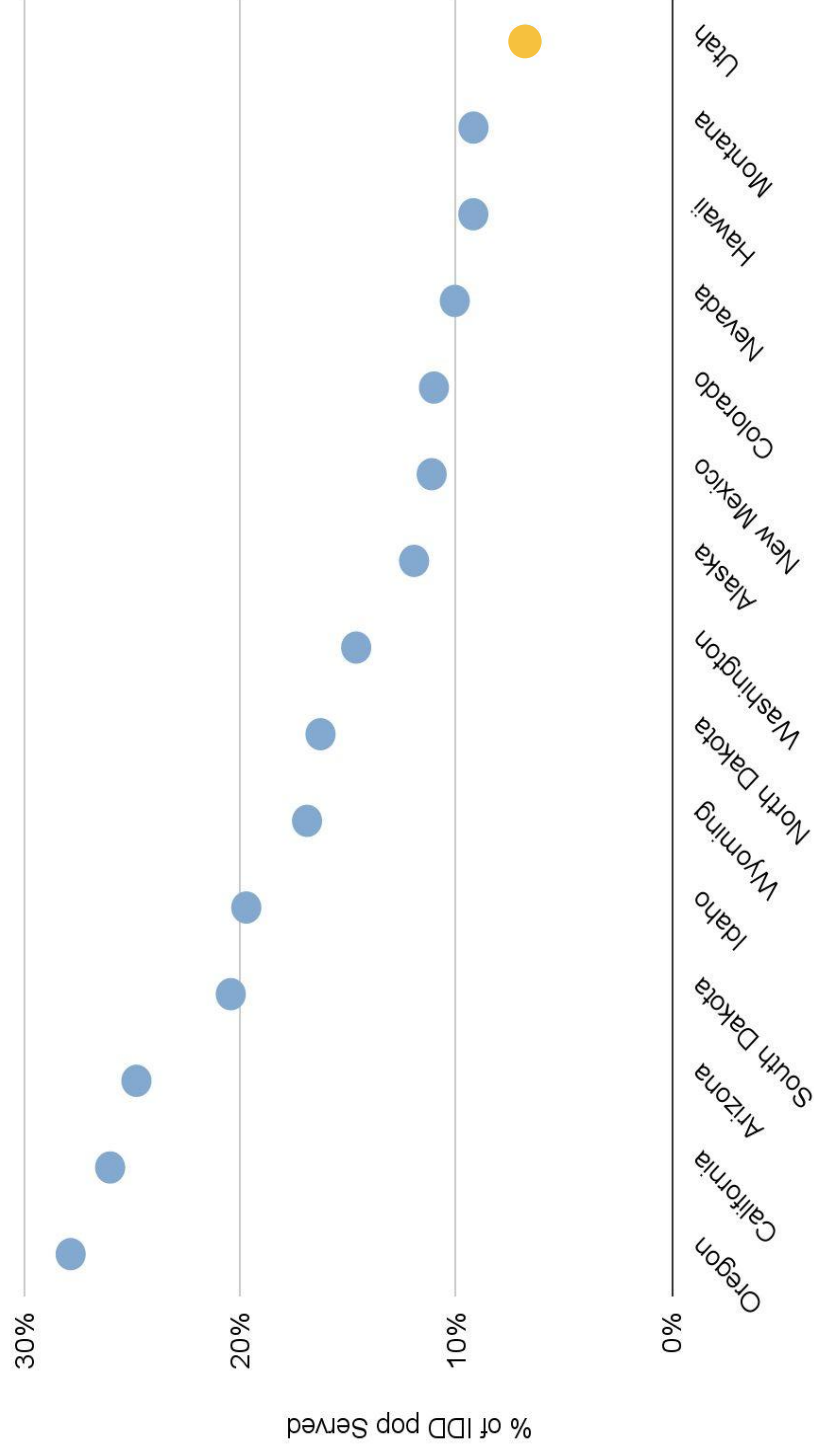

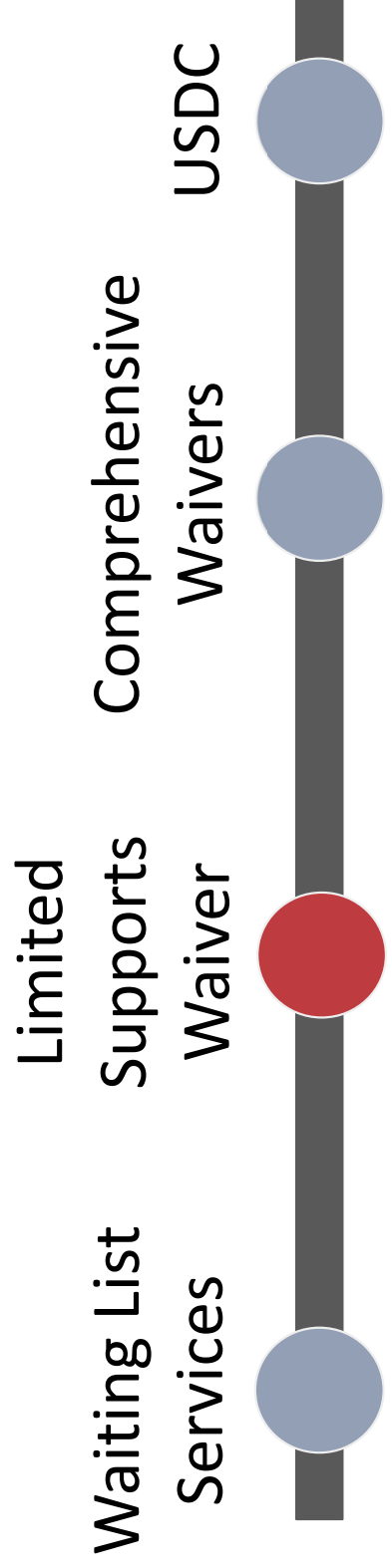
