WOMEN LEGISLATORS OF UTAH 1994-2024 \$40,000 FUNDING REQUEST

The book Women Legislators of Utah 1896-1993, compiled by Former Rep. Beverly White and Delila Abbott, President of the Utah Chapter Order of Women Legislators, was once widely distributed as an important historical resource and is now out of print. An electronic copy is available from the U's Marriott Library.

THE PROPOSAL:

In an effort to update this history and make it widely available across Utah, \$50,000 in legislative funding is being requested by the University of Utah College of Humanities under the direction of the Aileen H. Clyde Women's History Initiative at the University of Utah.

Graduate students from the University of Utah Department of History will be hired to write the history of Utah women legislators through personal interviews and research. Printed copies of the book will be sold and distributed free of charge to Utah libraries, schools, museums, and individuals. The timeline on this project is two years.
