- 502 is no longer a registered political party, the county clerk shall:
- 503 (a) change the voter's party affiliation to "unaffiliated"; and
- 504 (b) { mail notice to the voter: } notify the voter electronically or by mail:
- 505 (i) that the voter's affiliation has been changed to "unaffiliated" because the most recent
- 506 party affiliation designated by the voter is for a political party that is no longer a registered 507 political party; and
- 508 (ii) {<u>informing the voter</u>} of the methods and deadlines for changing the voter's party
 509 <u>affiliation.</u>
