Social Determinants of Health Data System

Social determinants of health are underlying factors that contribute to wide health disparities and inequities. Sufficient resources at the community level are needed to drive equitable access to health, education, transportation, housing, food security, and income.

Improve care coordination through technology

A Community Information Exchange (CIE) is an electronic ecosystem comprised of multidisciplinary network partners that use a shared language, a resource database, and an integrated technology platform to deliver enhanced community care planning. Funding will be used to contract with a vendor to develop components of a CIE.

Integrating public health with community-development strategies

The CIE will help to coordinate social services between government agencies, health care providers, and community-based organizations. Community trust and engagement in the development and design is vital to success. The development of this system will be tested and piloted at the community level prior to scaling up.

This effort will be coordinated with the development of a statewide Master Person Index that will allow the support and interoperability of multiple social determinants of health referral platforms. Increasing care coordination of social services through a CIE will help us understand and address social and place-based determinants that are linked to health disparities. This effort will guide us in improving health and advancing health equity.
