## **FLEET EXPANSION**

The Division of Fleet Operations is required to make rules for the procurement of state vehicles (UCA  $\underline{63A-9-401(1)(d)(v)}$ ). By rule the division requires that to expand its fleet an agency or institution must obtain legislative approval (R27-4-5). Institutions within the Utah System of Higher Education request fleet expansion as shown in the table below.
