- 73 (13) In IBC, the following is added below Table 1106.1: "Where two or more
- 74 accessible spaces are required, a minimum of one space shall be designated as a wheelchair
- 75 parking space{, with physical dimensions of 11 feet wide and adjacent to an access aisle at least
- 76 five feet wide}. This shall be in addition to the van-accessible space or spaces required by

104 (e) "Wheelchair parking space" means an accessible parking space that is marked for
