

HB374S1: Sensitive Materials in Schools

Why is HB374 needed?

Utah Parents are deeply concerned that materials portraying and depicting “sexually explicit conduct” as well as “sexual conduct” as defined in the Utah Criminal Code (UCA [76-5b-103](#) and [76-10-1201](#)) are currently found in books and materials in K-12 schools throughout the state.

What does HB374 do?

HB374 prohibits from Utah’s K-12 schools all materials that describe or depict “sexually explicit conduct” as defined in Utah’s Criminal Code (Sexual Exploitation) [76-5b-103](#) and “sexual conduct” as defined in Utah’s Criminal Code (Pornography) [76-10-1201](#).

- Excludes approved health curriculum under [53G-10-402](#), medical courses, and other materials specifically exempted by the state board.
- Requires the state board to consult with the Utah Attorney General’s office to provide guidance and training to schools regarding what constitutes “sensitive materials” under HB374 which are prohibited from Utah K-12 schools.
- Requires the state board and LEAs to report to the Education and Government Operations Interims Committees at or before the November interim meetings on rules and policies to implement HB374.
