




#### Utah's Unified Transportation Plan



The transportation agencies are evaluating and updating transportation funding for state and local roads, transit, and active transportation.


This includes assessing the adequacy of current funding sources in meeting long-term needs for capacity-enhancing projects, operations and maintenance, and preservation/state of good repair.






#### Needs and Revenues through 2050


