2022 General Session Affordable Housing Appropriations

Olene Walker Housing Loan Fund

- Section 8 Landlord Incentive Program
 - FY 2023 \$375,000; FY 2024 \$375,000
- Statewide Affordable Housing Database
 - \$500,000 one-time
- Land Use Training and Workshops
 - \$250,000 one-time
- Local Zoning and Housing Regulation Reform
 - \$250,000 one-time
- Utah County Refugee Housing
 - \$300,000 one-time
- First Time Homeowner Down Payment Assistance
 - \$5 million one-time
- Utah Housing Preservation Fund
 - \$15 million one-time

New for 2023

- Subcommittee to the Unified Economic Opportunity Commission
- Three focus areas:
 - Rural
 - ≤80% AMI (Low Income)
 - 81% 120% AMI (Attainable)

- The Unified Economic Opportunity Commission will vet proposals from the Commission on Housing Affordability to determine viable housing policies and solutions from the three focus areas
- Forthcoming database will inform stakeholders where existing affordable units are, the unit type and when the deed restrictions will expire
- Municipalities Moderate Income Housing Implementation Plans should start to produce additional affordable units statewide
