



Master Plan Blueprint

- 10 or more years
- Supported by governor and other executive and legislative leaders
- Guides the restructuring of policy, programs, and funding
- Focuses on aging well in the community.
- Connects the public, private, and independent sectors touching all major areas of the aging life experience
- Brings visibility to population aging priorities using data and stakeholder input
- Establishes measurable outcomes to address priorities
- Addresses differences across urban and rural localities
- Equitable and inclusive
- Is iterative, to be reviewed and updated over time
