Subject: Performance Measure Follow up from October 2021

In the October 2021 Social Services Appropriations Subcommittee, the committee passed a motion asking the Department of Health & Human Services to report back on the performance measures below in the October 2022 meeting.

(1) Behavioral Health Workforce Reinvestment - Total underserved individuals served.

Motion: The Department of Health should report the following performance measure as part of its annual performance measure report for 2022: *Total underserved individuals served*

(2) Social Detox Expansion for Medicaid

1. Initiation - 2021: 41.9% (baseline: 38.0%) **Target met**
2. Engagement - 2021: 15.4% (baseline: 11.6% [note that the previously reported baseline used

a different methodology for the denominator. We have updated our denominator to meet CMS Core Set standards]) **Target met**

3. Continuity - 2020: 23.8% (baseline: 25.9%) **Target not met**

4. Follow-up 7 - 2021: 28.9% (baseline: 33.0%) **Target not met**

5. Follow-up 30 - 2021: 45.6% (baseline: 50.5%) **Target not met**

(3) 2020 GS HB32 - Crisis Services Amendments

To this day, we have not had a free-standing MH residential IMD provider enroll with us. We are unable to report on this metric.

(4) 2020 GS SB44 - Limited Support Services Waiver Amendments (Motion passed at October 19, 2021 meeting).

Performance Measure:

If approved by the CMS, the department will implement a LSW waiver as described in SB44 by June 30, 2021.

Result: *This waiver has now been implemented.*
