CONVERGENCE HALL

Convergence Hall will house the Innovation District's work, including collaborative coworking space, classrooms, offices for universities, K-12 opportunities, and much more. Ground-level retail will offer restaurants and shopping that foster a vibrant environment for the community to live, work, and play.

Three key elements include:

- Utah Innovation Lab University Office
- Space STEM-Focused Makerspace

INNOVATION LAB

The Utah Innovation Lab will serve as an incubator and accelerator for researchers and entrepreneurs seeking to commercialize their cutting-edge technologies. The Lab will provide critical resources such as start-up funding, training, and direct access to industry professionals.

UNIVERSITY PRESENCE

Convergence Hall will provide much- needed office space for Utah's institutions of higher education to collaborate on areas of shared interest, breaking down siloes, increasing efficiencies, and adding unprecedented value to Utahns. Each university will have a team with a physical presence at The Point that will also collaborate with their respective institutions to capitalize on synergies statewide.



STEM LEARNING



\$50 million in one-time state funding is needed to build Convergence Hall.

- \$300,000 Planning
- \$4 Million Design
