Renovated Space

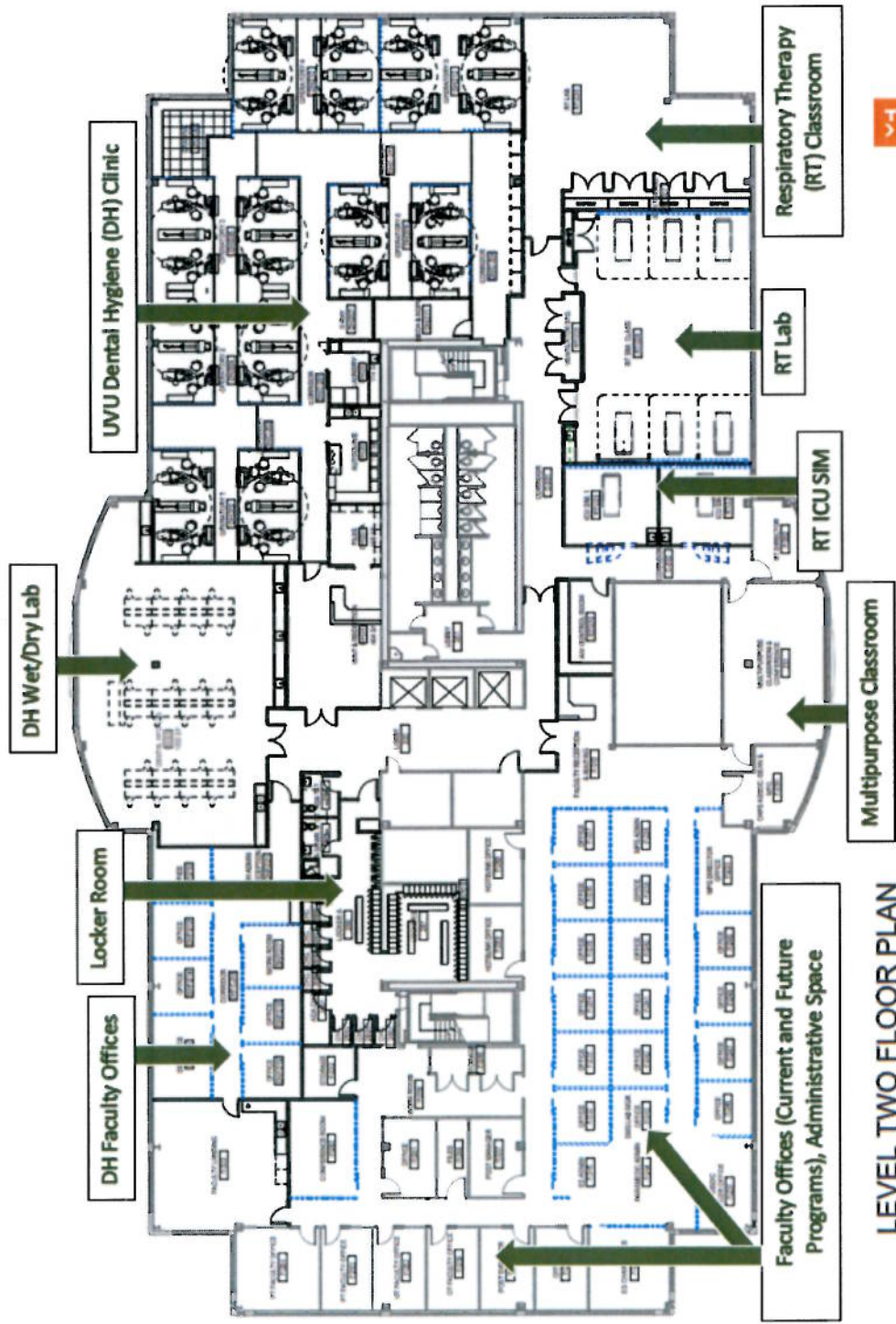
Approximately 2,292 graduates in the next decade

- 500 Law Enforcement Officers

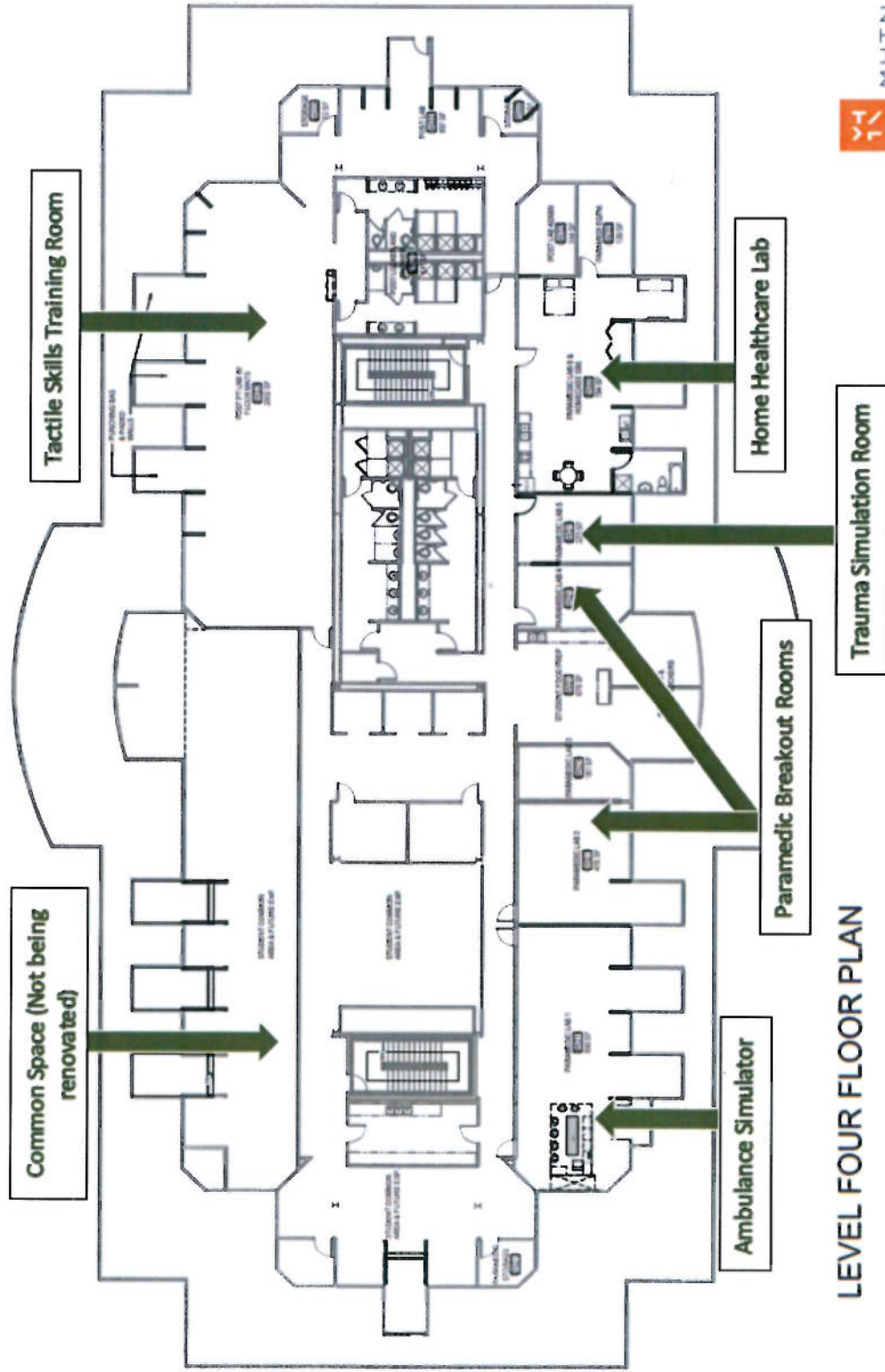
Expanded Dental Hygiene Clinic will serve 3,200+ patients annually, an increase of 50% initially

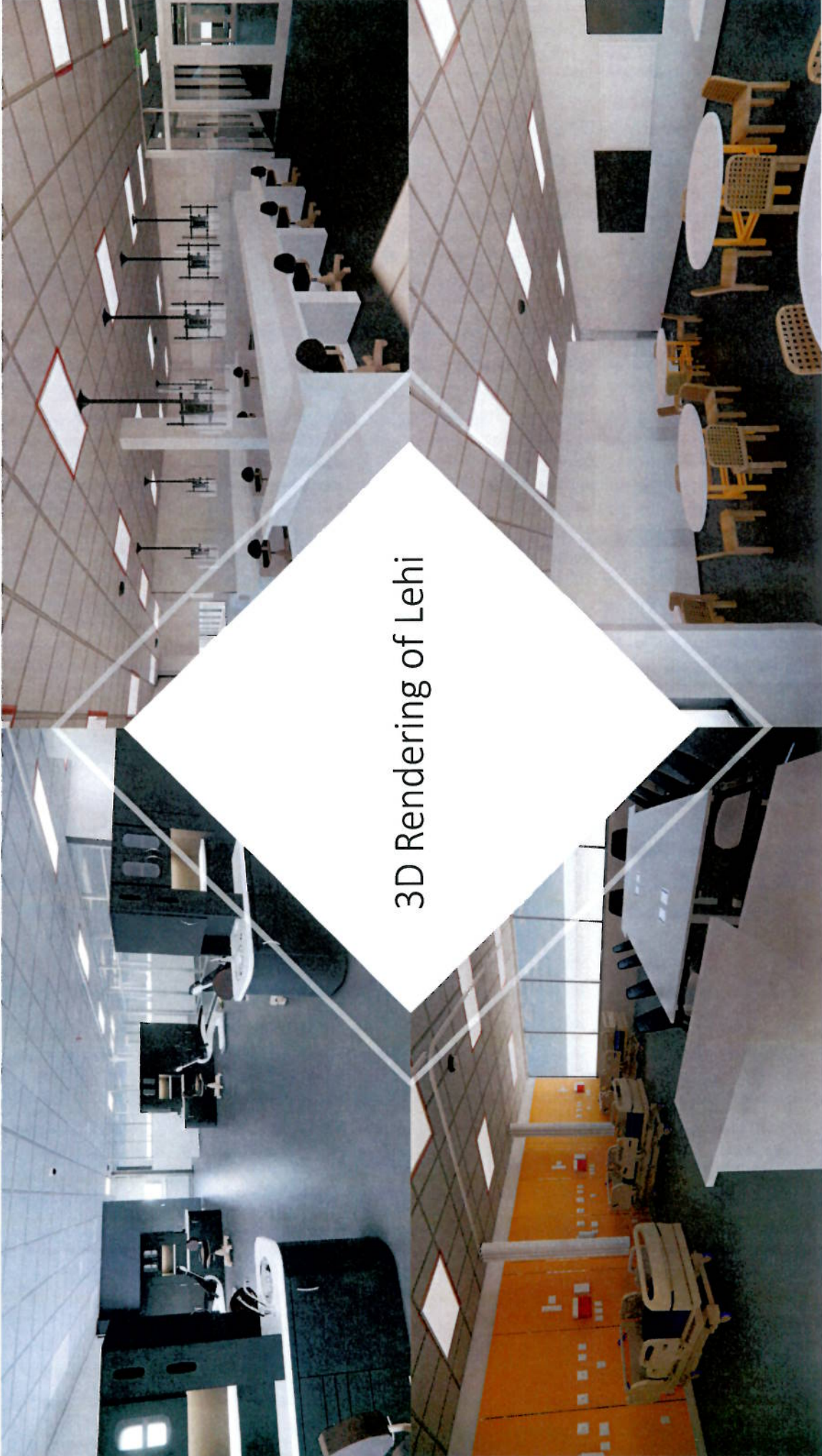


LEVEL TWO FLOOR PLAN
