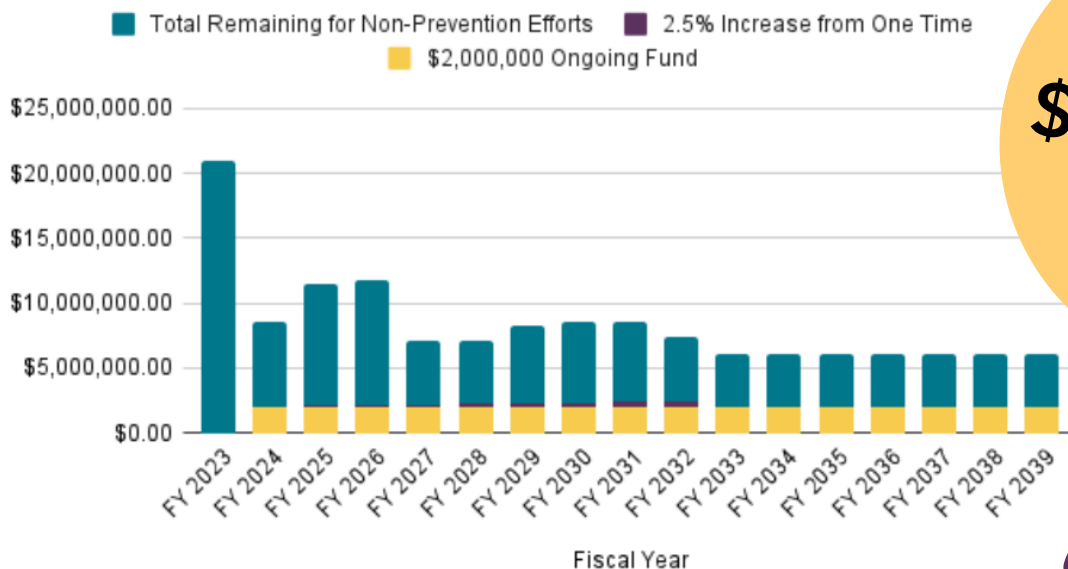

Investment in Primary Prevention by 2.5% each year for the first 9 years

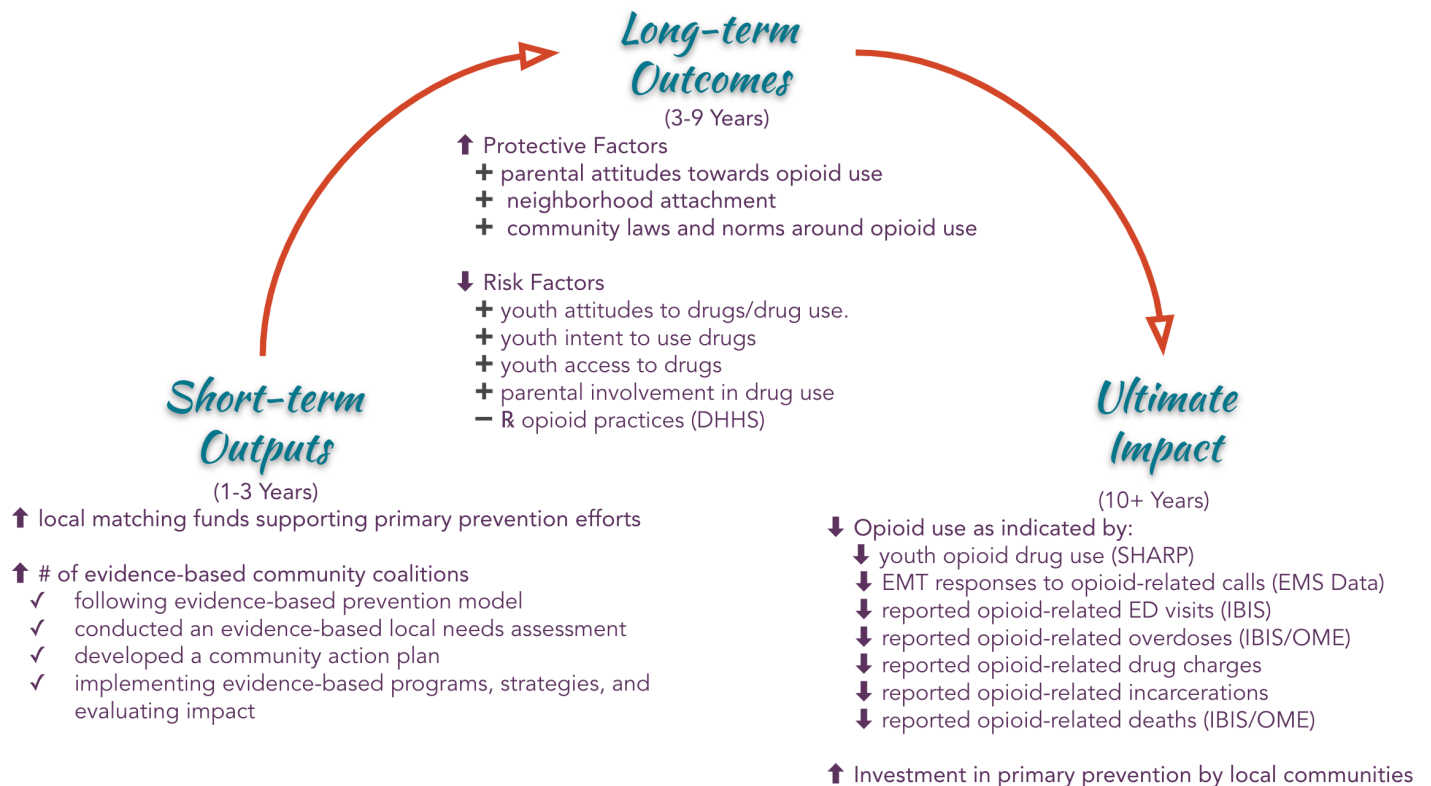


Local community investment in Primary Prevention by instituting a matching requirement

Measurable Outcomes



Shifting Upstream

Opioid settlement funding provides an unprecedented opportunity for our state to change how we address the issue of opioid addiction in our communities by moving further upstream. This can be accomplished by systematically increasing our investment in evidence-based primary prevention strategies at the community level. Slowly increasing our investment by 2.5% each year over the course of the settlement will allow us to address the immediate treatment needs of the crisis while moving our efforts upstream to prevent opioid use and addiction from occurring.

Distributing the funds to the Local Substance Abuse Authorities through a formula will ensure greater equality in the distribution of the funding earmarked for evidence-based primary prevention.
