









Enrollment History-FTE




Attainment Goal Metrics - Access




Share of awards completed within 1.5 time (6 years for a bachelor's degree)




Share of awards that lead to high-wage, high demand fields



Water Conservation Efforts

- Irrigation and building water consumption has been cut 36% from baseline (2014)


Energy Conservation Efforts

Energy Performance (kBtu/Student FTE)





 - Multiple facility remodel and upgrade projects delayed by COVID and supply chain challenges




