From 2019-2021, the above health centers saw:



65% increase in MAT/MOUD patient visits (+569 visits, 1440 total in 2021)



26% increase in MAT/MOUD providers (+10 providers, 49 total in 2021)

Funding will support the following:

- Approximately 1,900 new and existing MAT/MOUD patients annually
- 23 FTEs supporting MAT/MOUD care
- Education and prevention program in rural communities
- Mobile MAT/MOUD programs to support unsheltered patients
