2021: 27% STUDENTS CHRONICALLY ABSENT

DATA INDICATES THAT 27.2% OF STUDENTS WERE CHRONICALLY ABSENT IN THE 21-22 SCHOOL YEAR AS COMPARED TO 19.0% IN THE 20-21 SCHOOL YEAR AND 12.9% IN THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR.




