78 system is accessible to a physician designated by the patient, preferably through the use of

79 <u>single login.</u>} <u>Beginning July 1, 2025, each hospital system shall ensure for a patient receiving care in their hospital that the patient's medical information maintained by all of the hospital systems is accessible to a physician designated by the patient, preferably through the use of single login.</u>

2. 1st Sub. S.B. 91 Medical Cannabis Regulation Amendments (Vickers, E.)

Amendment 1 1st Sub. S.B. 0091

1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 17:

16 modifies labeling requirements including requiring additional warning labels { for

17 certain products };

2. Page 20, Lines 591 through 599:

591 (v) includes a warning label that states:





592 (A) for a container labeled before July 1, 2021, "WARNING: Cannabis has

593 intoxicating effects and may be addictive. Do not operate a vehicle or machinery under its

influence. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product is for medical use only. Use

595 only as directed by a qualified medical provider."; { or }

596 (B) for a container labeled on or after July 1, 2021, "WARNING: Cannabis has

597 intoxicating effects and may be addictive. Do not operate a vehicle or machinery under its

598 influence. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product is for medical use only. Use

599 only as directed by a recommending medical provider."[-]; and

(C) for a container labeled on or after January 1, 2024, that using the product in the container may cause a mental illness; and

3. Page 21, Lines 621 through 626:

621 (a) shall make rules to establish:

622 (i) a standard labeling format that:

623 (A) complies with the requirements of this section; and

624 (B) ensures inclusion of a pharmacy label; { and }

625 (ii) additional requirements on packaging for cannabis and cannabis products to ensure

626 safety and product quality; and

(iii) the exact wording for a label described in Subsection (1)(b)(v)(C); and
