

OBJECTIVES AND RESULTS

Levels the extracurricular playing field for students not attending UHSAA affiliated schools

Current statute prohibits homeschooled students and students attending charter or private schools from participating in extracurricular activities outside of their boundary school



H.B. 209 enables these students to use their first entry to join school teams outside of their boundary school's borders

H.B. 209 ensures that this only applies to students upon first entry, such that students can't withdraw from a school and transfer to another and receive the same benefit



Additionally, these students may only participate if the school is not over capacity
