
MOBILE BUSINESS FREEDOM

HB 408 takes the existing state law established for food trucks – such as business license reciprocity – and extends them to mobile businesses that look and operate almost identically to food trucks, but that do not sell food.

HB 408 adds a definition for "Enclosed Mobile Businesses" to state code and enables microentrepreneurs who wish to operate such businesses the certainty that if they get a permit, pass any required inspections, and abide by lawful city and county regulations, they can operate throughout Utah without the hassle and cost of redundant processes.
