County Sheriff Amendments

What does H.B. 374 do?

Repeals the sections of code specific to counties of the first class that enabled the creation of the Unified Police Department



Makes municipalities' approach to providing law enforcement services uniform across the state.

Municipalities have the ability to either contract with the county sheriff to provide policing services, form their own police force, contract with another municipality, or join with other municipalities to create an interlocal policing service.



This change goes into effect July 1st, 2025--enabling the SLCo County Sheriff, UPD, UPD member cities/townships, and Salt Lake County to plan how to unwind UPD and provide the best policing services to meet the needs of these communities in the future.
