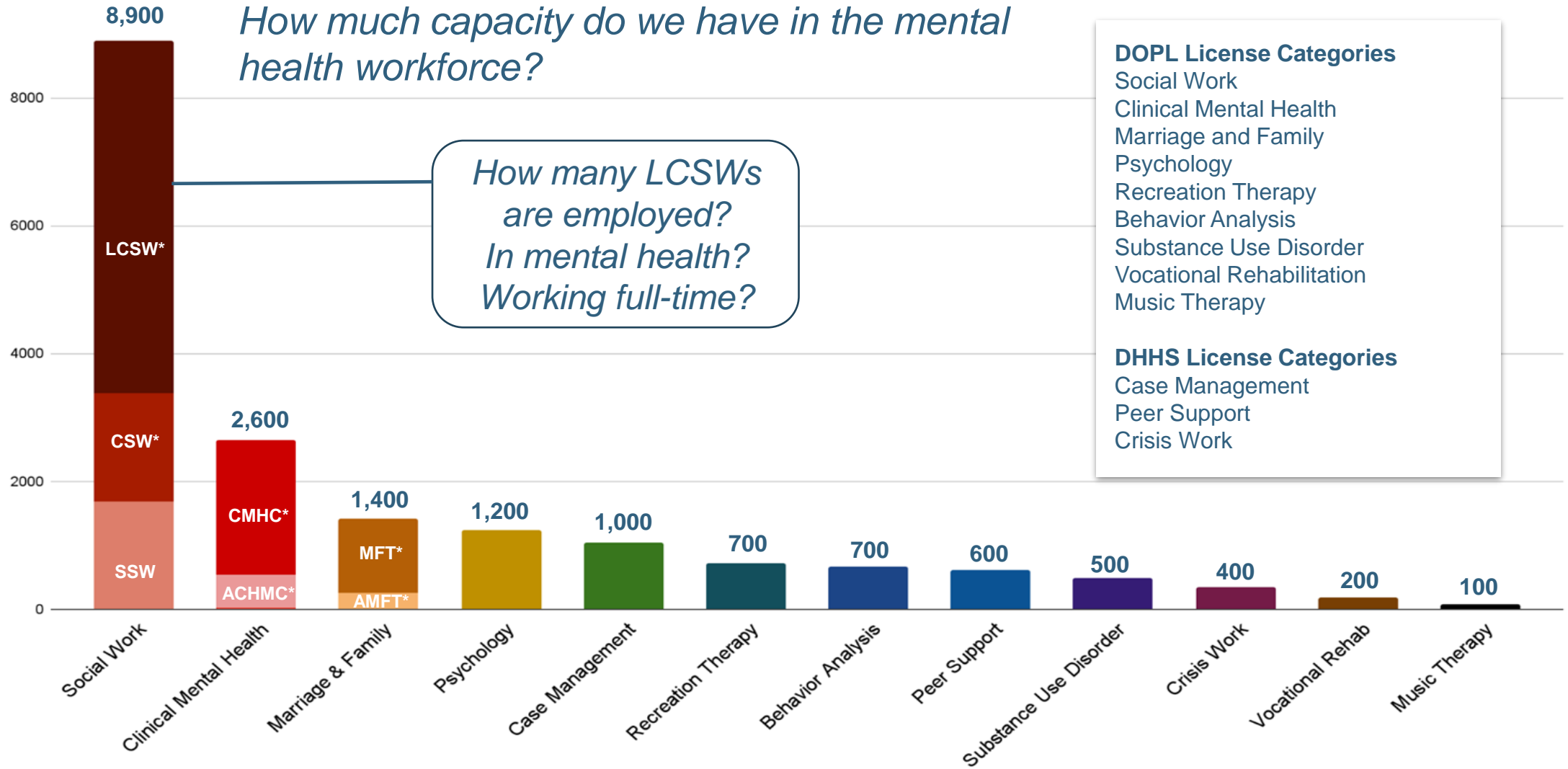


# #1: UTAH'S MENTAL HEALTH WORKFORCE

Active Licensees

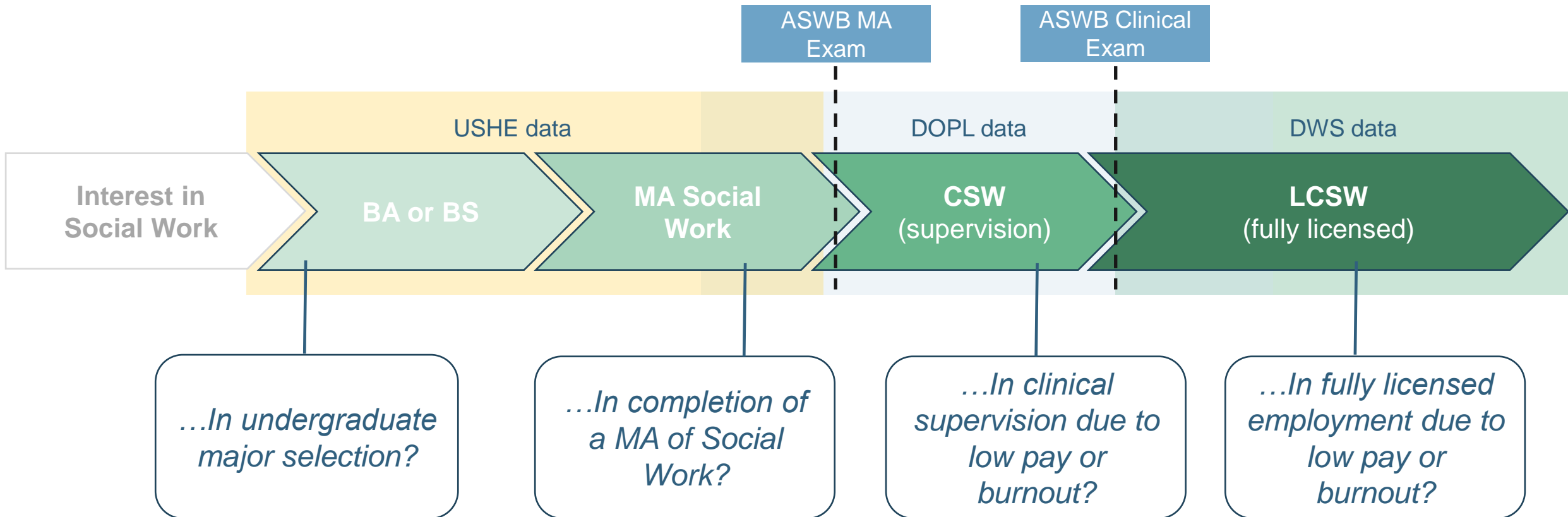


\*Master's level licensed clinical therapists are allowed to diagnose, create treatment plans, and provide mental health therapy.
