

H.B. 358 County Auditor Amendments



What does H.B. 358 do?

Enables auditors serving counties of the first class to initiate an audit when they deem necessary



Clarification and Definitions

Improves definition of performance audits, and clarifies what audits intend to measure



Establishes County Auditor's Independence

In effect, this bill provides the auditor of Salt Lake County the independence to conduct performance audits according to generally accepted government auditing standards (GAGAS).



Collaboration Between Auditor and Legislative/Executive Branch

Audits will continue to be conducted according to the measurements and outcomes established by the legislative or executive branch of county government.
