41 House or Representatives, no more than two of whom may be from the same political party;

42 (b) one member of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate; { and }

43 (c) the attorney general, or a designee of the attorney general (-):

(d) one member of the Utah League of Cities and Towns; and

(e) one member of the Utah Association of Counties.

(4) (a) The speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one of the members
