- 1. Page 2, Lines 31 through 36:
- 31 (2) The office may distribute the money from the grant program to a private landowner:
- 32 (a) that applies to the office, in a manner prescribed by the office, to receive all or part
- 33 of the money contained in the grant program; and
- 34 (b) for identifying and protecting archaeological resources on the landowner's property.
