H.B. 365 Voter Affiliation Amendments



What does H.B. 365 do?

Establishes a a deadline for party switching prior to the presidential primary in order to prevent party raiding



New Deadline

Shifts the party switching deadline to the day after the candidacy filing deadline

Exceptions to H.B. 365

These changes do not apply to unaffiliated voters and those who have recently moved to the state.





Central Objective

This bill aims to reduce party raiding, a practice by which members of a particular party conspire to swing the result of another party's primary election by entering a convention and strategically voting for a candidate that does not express the will of that party's voters.
