What is the Impact of BreakOut School?



BreakOut School Math Success

Average years of math proficiency below grade level at start of school	4 Grades Below
Average grade level INCREASE in FIRST year of BreakOut School	3.2
Percentage of BreakOut School Heroes who have achieved or EXCEEDED grade level proficiency	72%



BreakOut School's ELA Success

Average Writing Rubric Score at beginning of school	35%
Average Writing Rubric Score at end of FIRST year of BreakOut School	65%
