

Utah Medicaid by the Numbers








Medicaid Enrollment in Utah

Total enrollment as of April 2023:

510,000 individuals (due to continuous enrollment requirement of the public health emergency)

1 in 6 Utahns are covered by Medicaid


Medicaid Today

Address health equity and health outcomes through a focus on member experience and improved access and use of preventative services; facilitate whole-person care through integrated models that address physical, behavioral, and oral health; and where appropriate, transition fee for service payments to value based reimbursement methodologies.





Strategic Priorities

Transition Fee for Service ()4Reimbursements to Value Based Reimbursements

- FY 2024 DHHS will pay a portion of ACO contracts based on ACO performance in these quality areas:
 - Consumer engagement activities
 - National quality accreditation
 - Data submission standards
 - Preventive care performance
- FY 2024 DHHS will implement a quality plan for new hospital directed payments
