














Why did RVU locate in Utah? It is part of our Mission and Vision

RVUCOM prepares physicians dedicated to identifying areas of structural and sociopolitical imbalance of healthcare delivery by:


- Improving access to quality, competent, and timely healthcare for all

Health Professional Shortage Area – Primary Care in Utah

- Geographic HPSA "A high population to provider ratio in a rational, geographic area, or lower ratio with a high need demonstrated by specific health indicators."
- HPSA Population "A large percentage of specific, high-risk population group (e.g. low income, homeless, etc.) within a geographic area and a high population to provider ratio."








RVU Leading the Osteopathic Medical Education Board Scores (COMLEX I, II, III)

- COMLEX Level 1, Class of 2023
 - FIRST PLACE (98.6%) in first time pass rate (41 schools)
 - THIRD PLACE in overall mean (of 41 schools)
- COMLEX Level 2, Class of 2022
 - FIRST PLACE (100%) in first time pass rate (40 schools)
 - **FIRST PLACE** in overall mean (of 40 schools)
- COMLEX Level 3, Class of 2021
 - FIRST PLACE (100%) in first time pass rate (39 schools)
 - THIRD PLACE in overall mean (of 39 schools)








National Distribution of RVU-COM DO Graduates (2012-2022)

- 52% (960) of DO graduates practice a primary care specialty
- 29% (539) of DO graduates are located in a medically underserved area
- 43% (882) of DO graduates are located in a Primary Care HPSA
- 52% (802) of DO graduates are located in a rural area
