21	Section 1. Section 39A-3-201 is amended to read:
22	39A-3-201. Tuition and fees assistance for Utah National Guard members Use
23	and allocation Appropriation.
24	(1) (a) As used in this section, "fees" means general course fees, in addition to tuition,
25	that are:
26	(i) imposed by an institution of higher education; and
27	(ii) required to be paid by a student to engage in a course of study at the institution of
28	higher education.
29	(b) "Fees" [does not include] includes:
30	(i) a special course fee[:]; and
31	(ii) expenses for required:

33	(B) course related materials.
34	(2) The Utah National Guard may provide tuition and fees assistance to a member of
35	the Utah National Guard for study at an institution of higher education, subject to the following
36	requirements:
37	(a) the individual shall be, at the time the individual receives the assistance, an active
38	member of the Utah National Guard; and
39	(b) the assistance is for tuition and fees only and may not be more than the resident
40	tuition and fees for the actual course of postsecondary study engaged in by the individual.
41	(3) (a) Tuition and fees assistance shall be awarded as the adjutant general considers
42	necessary.
43	(b) An individual may apply to the adjutant general of the state for assistance for each
44	year during which the individual is an active member of the Utah National Guard.
45	(c) The adjutant general may recoup funds if a recipient fails to meet the requirements
46	of the program.
47	(4) The adjutant general of the state shall pay tuition and fees assistance directly to the
48	institution of higher education from the funds appropriated.
49	(5) The adjutant general of the state shall establish regulations, procedures, forms, and
50	reports necessary to administer the allocation of assistance and payment of funds under this
51	section.
52	(6) The adjutant general may use no more than 10% of the funds for administration of
53	the program as the adjutant general considers necessary.
